


<u>Interpretation:</u> I interpret this policy to mean that the District will establish and maintain a safe learning environment that promotes respect, encourages high student achievement, and works collaboratively with parents and other agencies to support students who may be having difficulty with behavioral issues.

Evidence of Status of Compliance:

- Unruly student behavior that disrupts the learning environment is addressed consistently and fairly.
- Student hearings are conducted by District Hearing Officers for students who have violated established codes of conduct and appropriate punishments are assigned. (See graphs for HCS's hearings, expulsions, and appeals to the District and to the School Board.)
- Meetings and trainings were held with school district administrators to discuss discipline issues, concerns, and procedures.
- Appeal Board training and reviews were held as necessary for District Appeal Board members to review procedures, district policies, and law.
- The District maintains a successful alternative program.
- The District has agreements with an outside agency to provide programs on tobacco, alcohol, and drug abuse prevention for our students.
