

Personalized Digital Learning (PDL) Plan

In November 2013, the first phase of the PDL initiative began when every middle school student and teacher received an Apple iPad. Since that time, Horry County Schools has placed devices in the hands of every student, grades 5-12. In 3rd and 4th grades, there is one device for every two students. The following chart shows both the history of the PDL devices and future plans.

The technology budget includes 9.1 million dollars per year from capital funds to support the PDL initiative, the laptop initiative, and other technology needs. The technology department plans to utilize the remaining fund balance for this year for the following items.

- 5th Grade Refresh: PDL plan includes that 5th grade student devices are replaced every four years. [\$1,610, 564]
- High School Projector Refresh: Replace approximately 320 desktop projectors with an interactive, mounted projector. [\$600,000]
- Firewall Replacement: Our current firewall is outdated and its warranty will expire in June 2019. [\$800,000]
- Teacher Laptop Upgrade: Latitude 5450 teacher laptops will be replaced in August 2019. [\$718,000]

- Server Upgrade [\$441,000]
- Camera Upgrade - Phase 2 [370,000]
- Television Messaging System Implementation [\$45,000]
- Administrative Desktop Refresh (secretaries, data quality clerks, and school check-in computer) [\$150,000]

- Backup Server Cluster Replacement [\$200,000]
