Background Information:

In 2015, Horry County Schools donated 0.50 acres of property from the Aynor High School property to the Aynor-Galivants Ferry Cultural Heritage Foundation for use in developing a Cultural Heritage Museum. The Foundation has recently decided to discontinue the museum activities. A reversion clause was included in the original deed and since the Foundation is ceasing their activities the property would come back to the District at no cost.
