*Whereas*, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and

*Whereas*, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

*Whereas*, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America, designating September 17th through 23rd as Constitution Week.

*Now with shared reverence*, I, Ken Richardson, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Chairman of the Horry County Board of Education, hereby proclaim the week of September 17th through 23rd, as
