

Collins Jollie Road Development: Attendance Area Designation

Policy Reference

OE-13, p. 43, Facilities: The superintendent shall assure that physical facilities support the accomplishment of the board's Results policies, are safe and properly maintained

Background Information:

A new, 673-acre development on Collins Jollie Road, with the potential for 1,983 housing units, is being proposed in the City of Conway. This proposed development is located within the current Conway Elementary attendance area. Conway Elementary is currently at 103% capacity. The location of this proposed development is adjacent to the Kingston Elementary attendance area. Kingston Elementary is currently at 77% capacity. The District has solicited the input of the Conway Area Advisory Board on the topic and discussed with them all the possible attendance area options for the proposed development. It was agreed that staff's recommendation to assign the proposed development to the Kingston Elementary attendance area was the preferred course of action. The grade 6-12 attendance area for this development would remain Conway Middle and Conway High, as currently designated.

Purpose:

To authorize the Facilities department to designate the proposed Collins Jollie Road development as part of the Kingston Elementary attendance area beginning in the 2020-21 school year.
