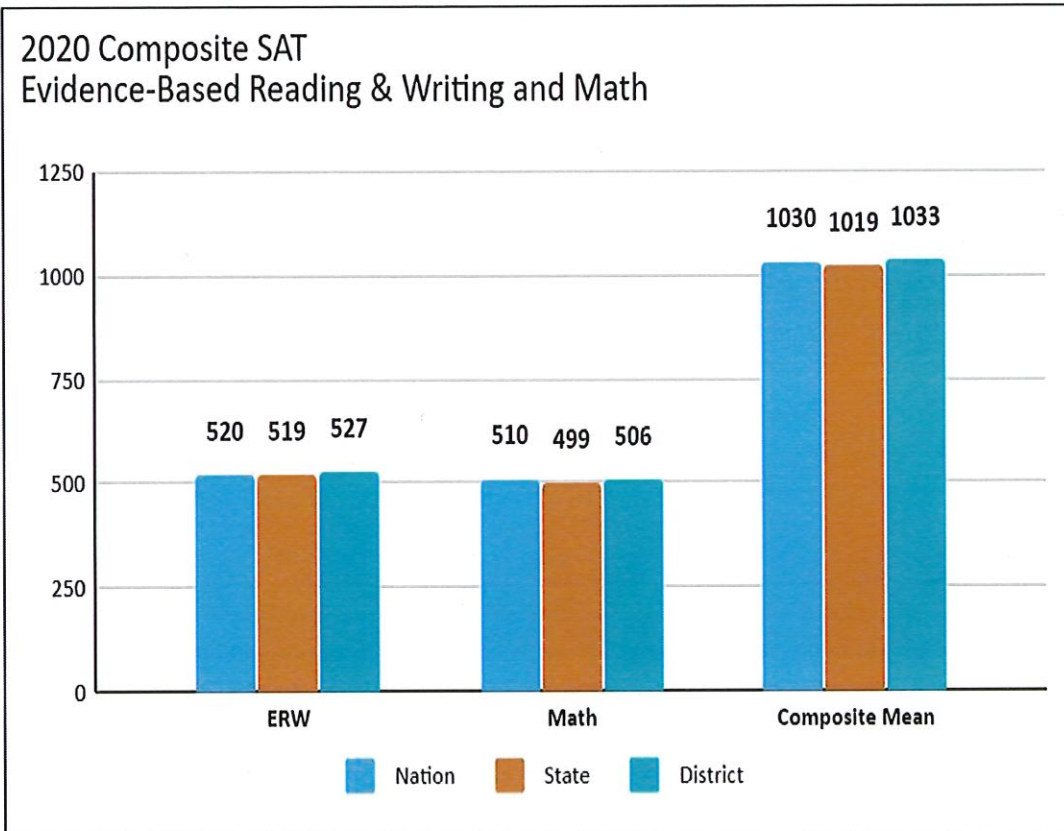

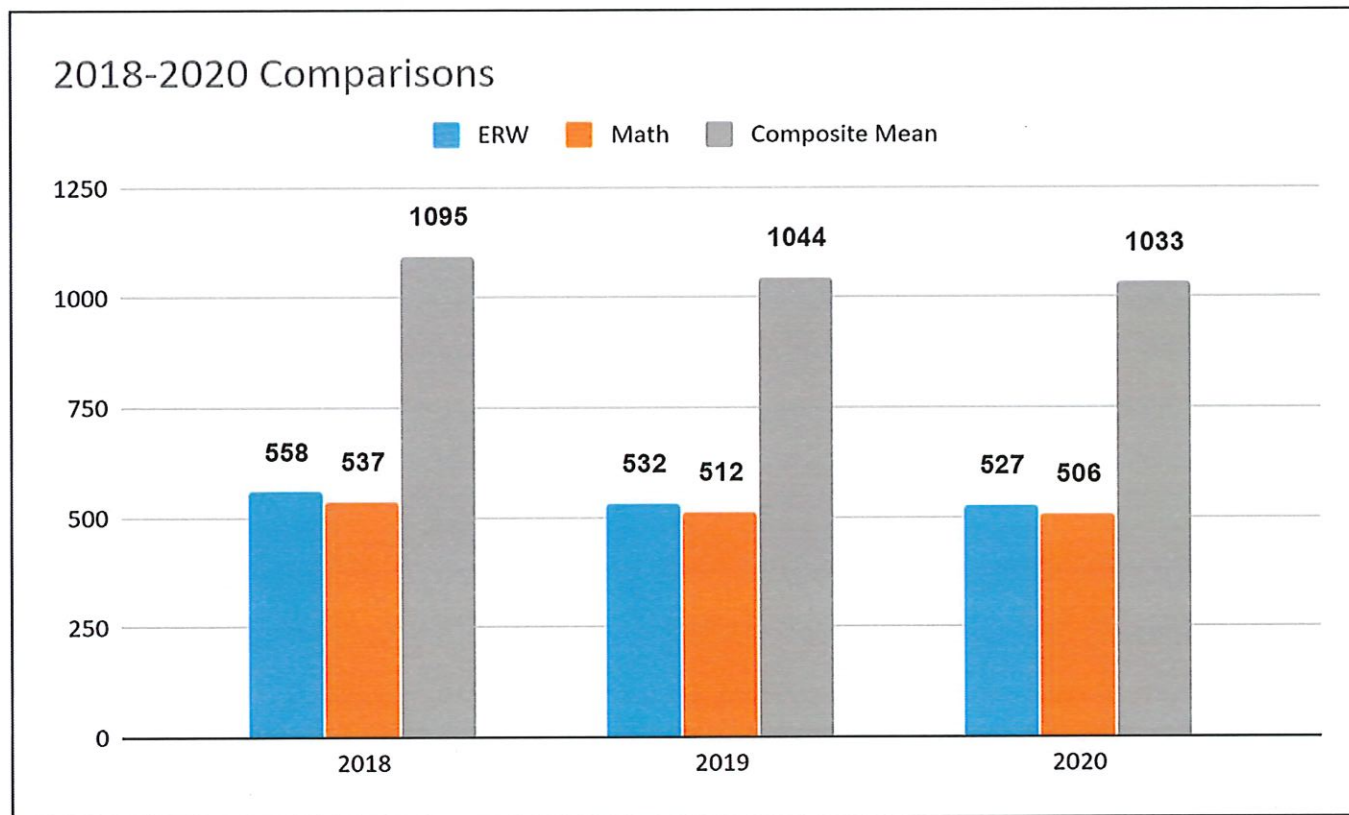

Longitudinal Comparison

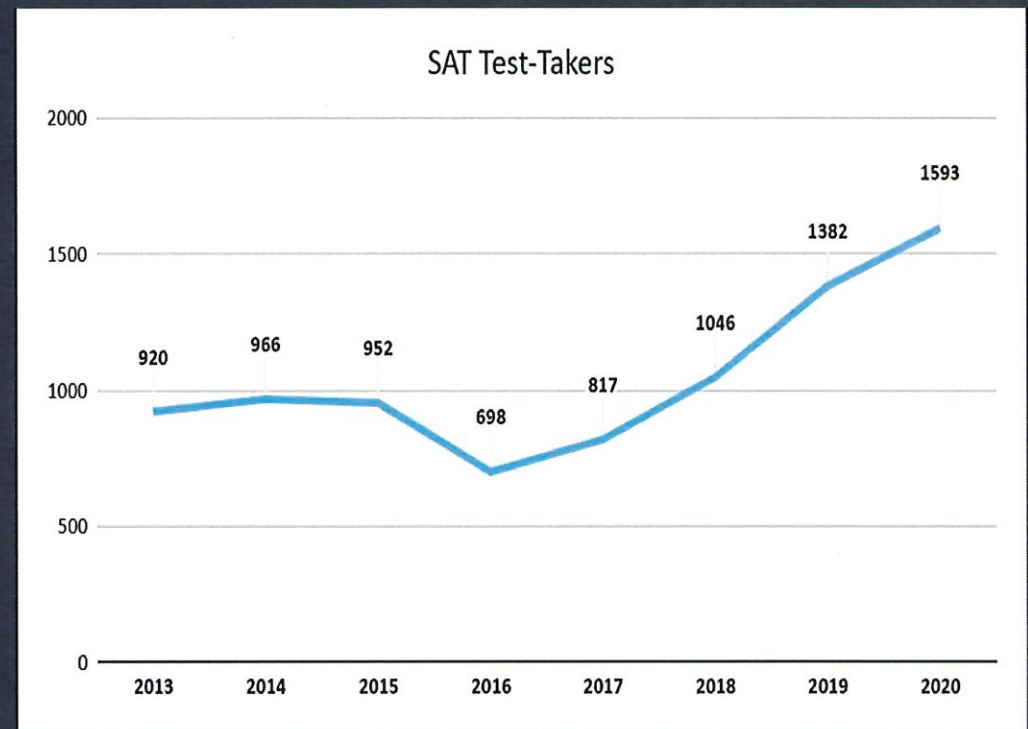

2020 Advanced Placement Performance

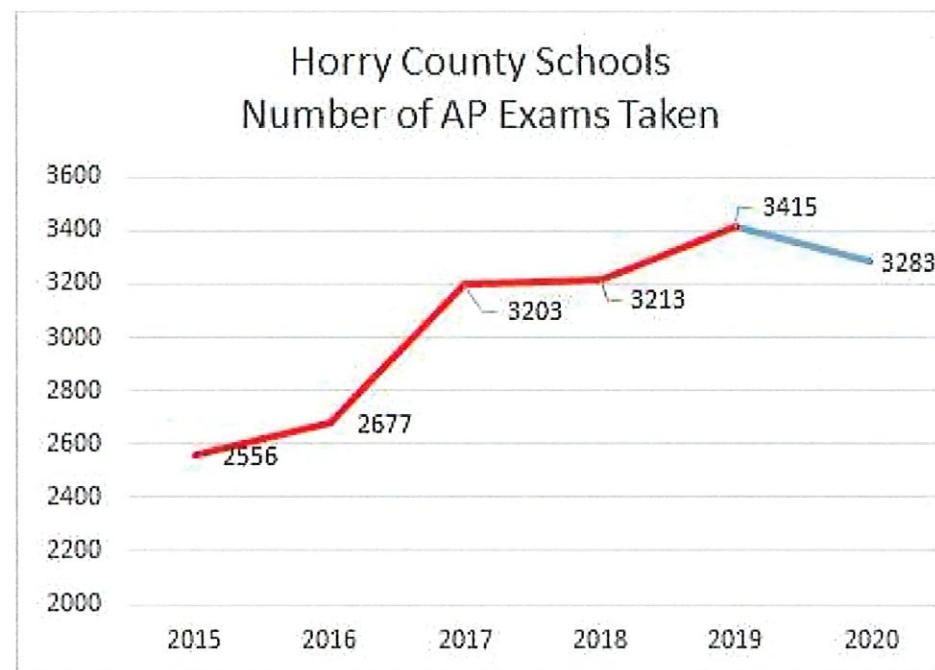
College Readiness Indicator Analysis

During the 2019-2020 school year, 2,145 HCS students participated in Advanced Placement classes, a 3 percent decrease from the previous year. HCS students took a total of 3,283 exams, compared to 3,415 exams taken the previous year.

Five district schools had 2020 pass rates (score of 3 or higher) that surpassed the state average of 62.2%.*

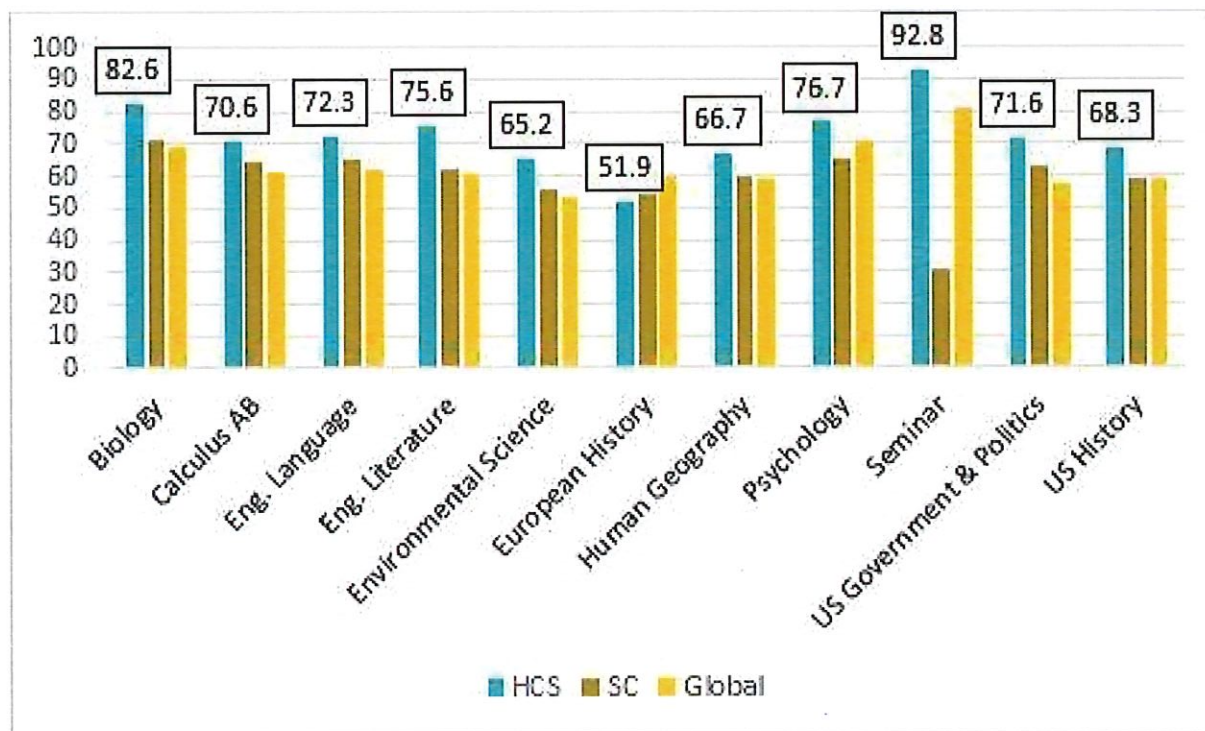

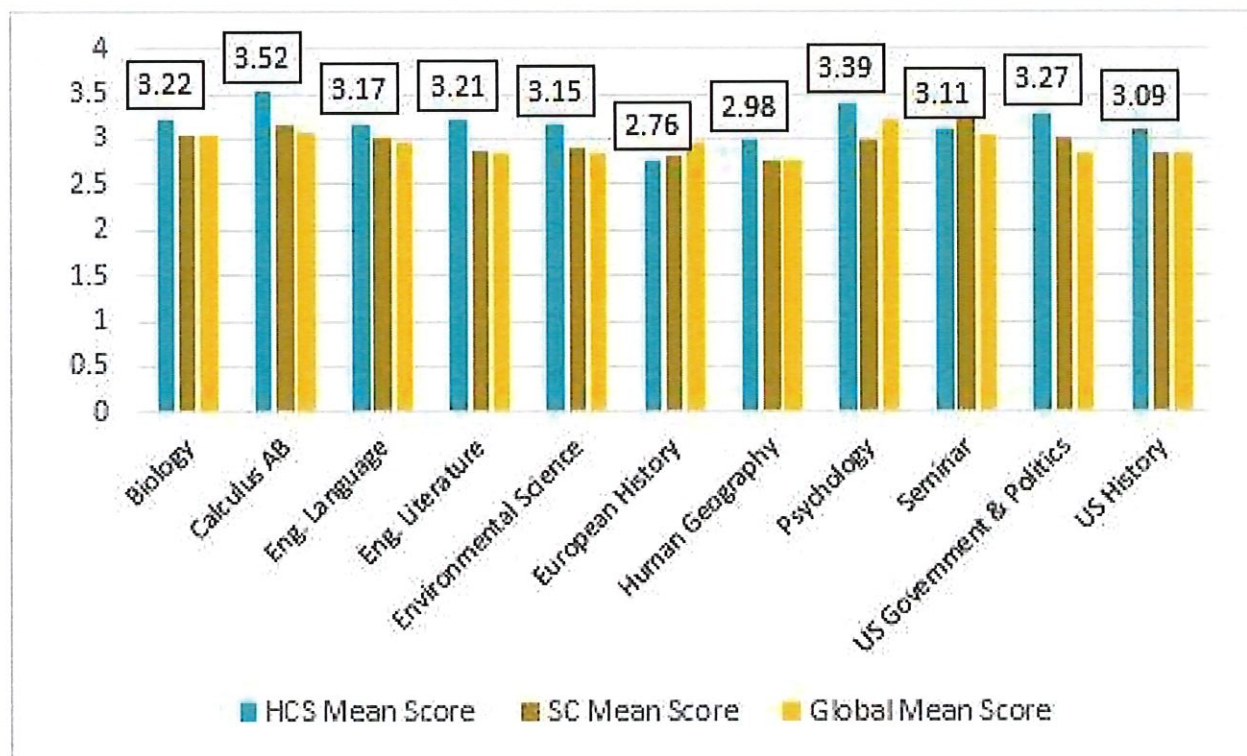
