APPROVAL OF THE 2021-2022 SUPERINTENDENT'S COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET

<u>Background Information</u>: The proposed 2021-2022 Superintendent's Comprehensive Budget was presented to the Board of Education at the May 3, 2021, Board meeting. The administration's General Fund Budget proposed the utilization of \$19,519,706 in unassigned fund balance.

At the May 17, 2021, Board meeting, a motion was approved to reactivate the Director of Athletics and add an additional assistant principal at Loris High School. Incorporating these additions, the amended 2021-2022 Superintendent's Comprehensive Budget was granted preliminary approval.

The amended General Fund Budget proposes the utilization of \$19,807,413 in unassigned fund balance.

Purpose: To provide an appropriation to meet the District's operational and capital needs.
