
Evidence of Status of Compliance:

In the Spring of 2022, the SCDE and Education Oversight Committee made significant adjustments to the accountability model by including results from the Teacher and Student Opinion Surveys into the School Climate indicator. Survey results are displayed on the annual school report card for the district and each individual school.

Survey results are displayed for three primary questions: "I am satisfied with the learning environment," "I am satisfied with the social and physical environment," and "I am satisfied with the home-school relations." The survey data is displayed under the Student Engagement indicator tab on the report card site.

The data below is a four-year longitudinal look at parent and teacher survey results. With the new online parent survey, HCS saw a 63 percent (3010) decrease in parent responses from the Spring 2021 survey. Beginning in 2019 two additional parent responses are included on the report card site: "My child feels safe at school," and "My child's teachers and school staff prevent or stop bullying at school." This data is reported only and not part of the rating calculation.

Another significant change was made with regard to the student population surveyed. Previously only students in the highest grade level within an elementary or middle school and students in 11th grade were administered a survey. In the Spring of 2022 the decision was made to include all students in grades 3 through 12 in the survey. The student responses, along with the teacher responses were scored and used to calculate each school's individual School Climate indicator worth 10 points on the school report card. The responses below are a 4-year comparison of student survey results.
