Perception of Stakeholders

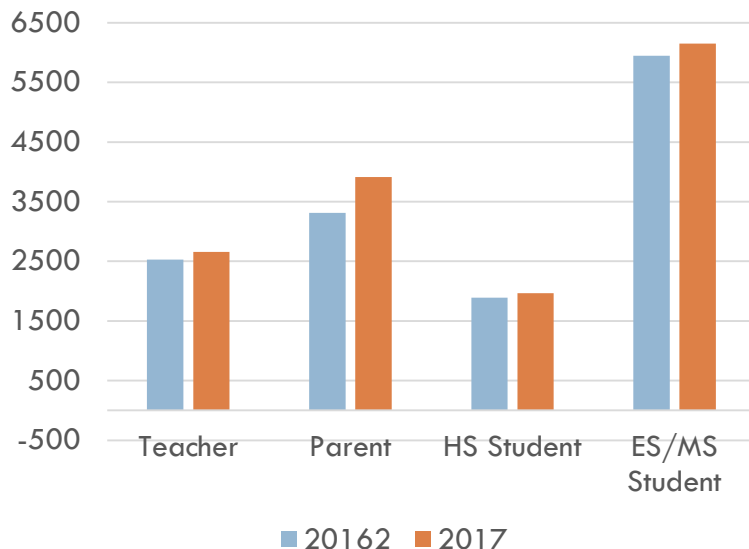

- Students in grade 5, 8 and 11 (online)
- Parents equal to number of students surveyed (paper)
