

Background Information: The Instructional Materials Division of the State Department of Education anticipates allocations to fund the subject areas up for adoption in the 2017-2018 school year. Selected materials will be placed in schools beginning August 2017. Recommendations are currently being made to support identified areas of **Middle School Science Kits and Career and Technology Education.**
