Background Information:

The Instructional Materials Division of the State Department of Education anticipates allocations to fund fully the subject areas up for adoption in the 2017-2018 school year. Selected materials will be placed in schools beginning August 2017. Recommendations are currently being made to support identified areas of Science 6-8, Foundations in Algebra and Intermediate Algebra, AP Chemistry, IB Chemistry, AP English Language and Composition, AP English Literature and Composition, AP European History, Sociology, Civics, AP Physics 1,2, AP Physics C, IB Physics, and AP World History.

All materials for this adoption went through the state public review process prior to consideration. The district adoption committee was comprised of teachers, school administrators, and a parent. School level representatives were instructed to vote based on input from all appropriate teachers in their schools.
