RECOMMENDATION FOR NAME, MASCOT AND COLORS FOR THE NEW MIDDLE SCHOOL IN THE CAROLINA FOREST ATTENDANCE AREA

Background Information:

The New Carolina Forest-Attendance Area Middle School Ad Hoc Naming Committee was formed in accordance with district policy. The Ad Hoc Naming Committee has considered the name, mascot and colors for the new middle school in the Carolina Forest attendance area. The Committee has recommended the following for the school:

Name: Ten Oaks Middle School

Mascot: Silver Fox

Colors: Burgundy, Black and Silver

The name Ten Oaks comes from the 10 majestic oak trees growing in a circle in the nearby General Isaac Huger Park. Revolutionary War General Isaac Huger received 1,000 acres in the area in 1771 as a grant from the King of England. He later fought alongside Francis Marion and Peter Horry in the Revolutionary War. Some of the trees may have been there as long as 300 years and are located less than a mile from the new school.

Purpose:

Review the Ad Hoc Naming Committee's recommendation for the Name, Mascot and Colors for the new middle school in the Carolina Forest attendance area.
