## College Readiness Goals

## ACT Changes

ACTwashistorically a voluntary college entrance exam taken by $50 \%$ or less of each year's graduating class of seniors until this year.
South Carolina made ACTa "census" test forall third-yearhigh school students in Spring 2015. That means that ALL students in the graduating class of 2016 had an ACTscore - for the first time in history.
