Hurricane Matthew Recovery Update

- **GETTING BACK IN BUSINESS!**
- All schools were operational by Friday, October 14th except the Green Sea Floyds attendance area (power not restored)
- Green Sea Floyds:
 - Friday, October 14th; 3 generators acquired; unknown power date
 - Sufficiently sized to power the both entire schools
 - Saturday, October 15th ; buildings were energized
 - Sunday, October 16th ; both buildings confirmed operational
 - Duke Power was subsequently able to restore an older line to temporarily back feed the Nichols and Lakeview areas.
 - Repairs completed and power restored to GSF area late Sunday, October 16th.
 - HCS has collaborated with Duke Power and GSWA to transition back to line power this Saturday, October 22nd
 - Transition time 3 hours / schools' large energy load

Storm Related Facts and Statistics:

- Before the storm:
 - 500+ HCS man hours preparing
 - Testing/fueling generators, sandbagging, securing loose items
- During the storm:
 - Responded to urgent needs for loss of power at shelters, etc.
- After the storm:
 - HCS knew status of 90% of locations by early afternoon, Sunday
 - 600+ HCS man hours spent assessing conditions
 - 500+ storm-related work orders: (2 x October flood figures)
 - 170+ trees lost at 52 locations
- As of yesterday, over 1000 HCS man hours in tree / debris removal
- THANKS to all HCS departments for superb collaborative efforts!
- THANKS to all utility companies after the storm!
 - No significant loss of water / sewer services
 - Monday: 34 locations had no power
 - Tuesday: 26 were restored = 8 w/o
 - Wednesday: 3 more restored = 5 w/o
 - Thursday: All restored except 2 at GSF






