# **Instructional Materials Adoption Recommendations** 2016 - 2017

**Policy Reference:** OE-8: The superintendent shall assure that the board is fully and adequately informed about matters relating to board work and significant organizational concern.

**Background Information:** The Instructional Materials Division of the State Department of Education anticipates allocations to fully fund the subject areas up for adoption in the 2016-2017 school year. Selected materials will be placed in schools beginning August 2016. Recommendations are currently being made to support identified areas of Science K-5, Social Studies K-5, U.S. Government 9-12, Biology 9-12 and International Business Application 9-12 (CATE).

All materials for this adoption went through the state public review process prior to consideration. The district adoption committee was comprised of teachers, curriculum coaches, school and district administrators, and a parent. School level representatives were instructed to vote based on input from all appropriate teachers in their schools.
