Canopies have been completed for Modular Units at MBP, AE and BE. New Canopies for NMBM and SJH are under construction and projected to be completed by January 13th. Canopy layouts for SJM are in progress and canopy

construction for SJM will start on January 7th and completion will take 3 weeks. After canopies are complete at SJM, the contractor will move to FBM which will take 2 to three weeks to complete and then will move to SSE in February. SSE will take 3 weeks to complete. All canopies should be complete by the first week

of March and will complete all canopies in the Canopy Project.
