



2015 Summer Reading Camp

Act 284 Read to Succeed and Proviso 1.79 mandate that all districts in South Carolina must provide the opportunity for current third-grade students who are “substantially not meeting proficiency in reading” to attend a summer reading camp. Proviso 1.79 also allows districts to extend the opportunity to first- and second-grade students who lack reading proficiency. Students are invited but not required to participate in the summer reading camp.

What is the purpose of the 2015 HCS Summer Reading Camp?

- The purposes of the HCS Summer Reading Camp are to teach students strategies to assist them in increasing their reading skills as well as to introduce some content required for success at the next grade level.
- The program of study includes whole and small group literacy instruction as well as writing, research, and inquiry. Students will also have access to digital learning content and be able to check out materials from the school’s media center.
