Second grade reading level

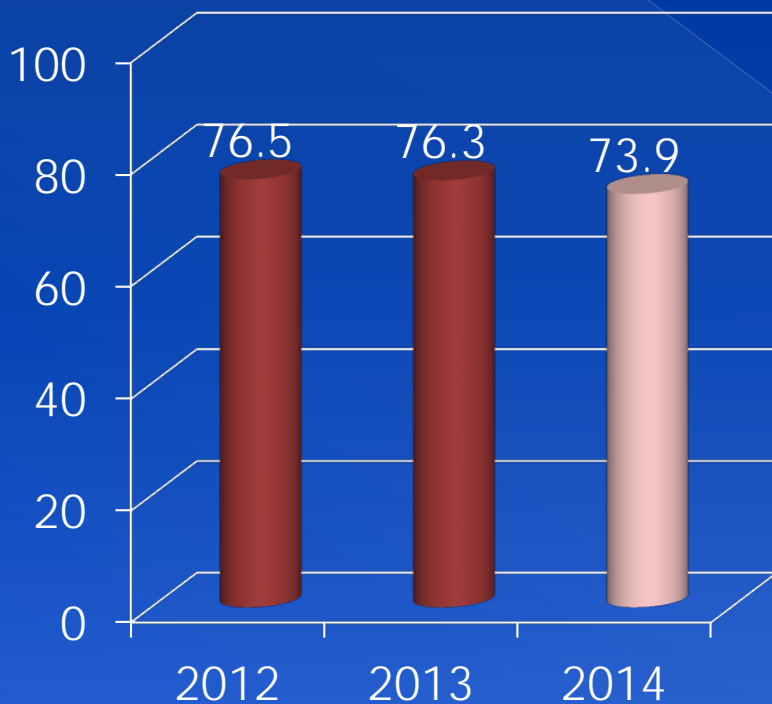
Power Goal 1: Reading/ELA

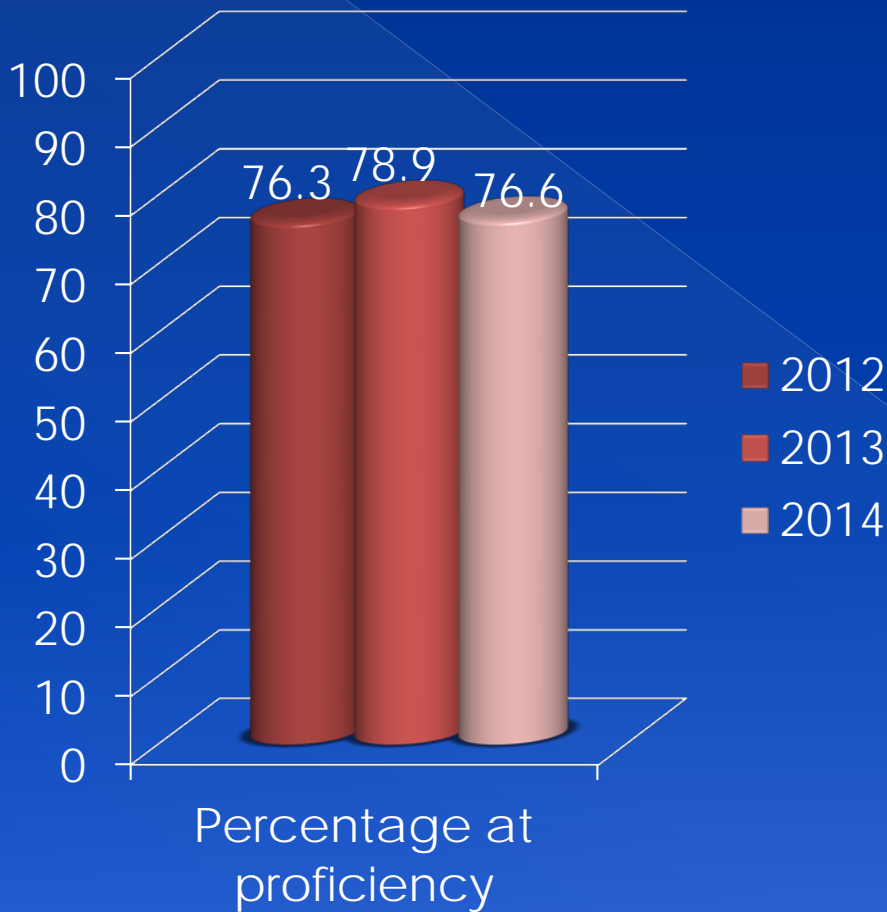
Proficiency level grades 3-HS

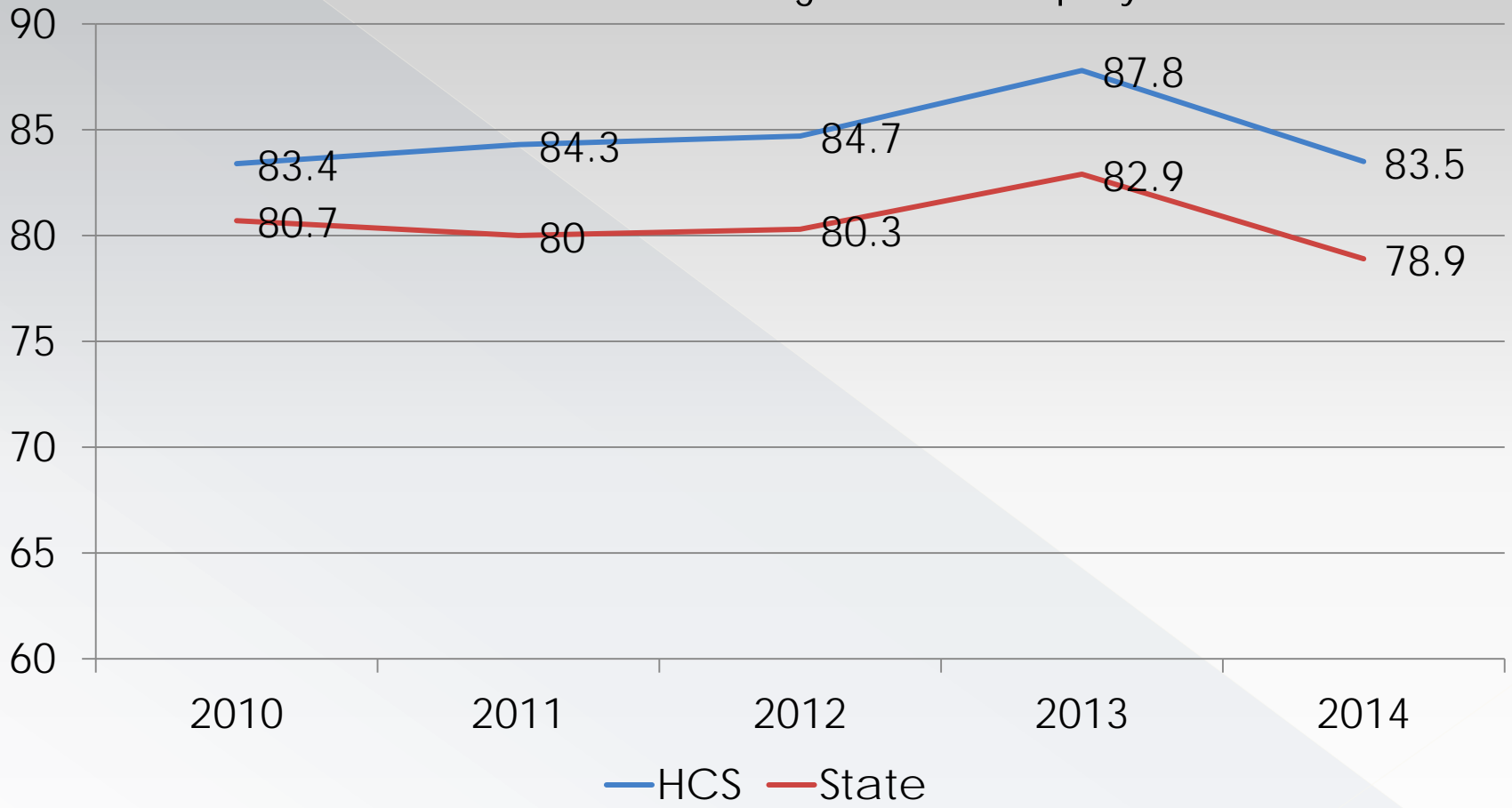

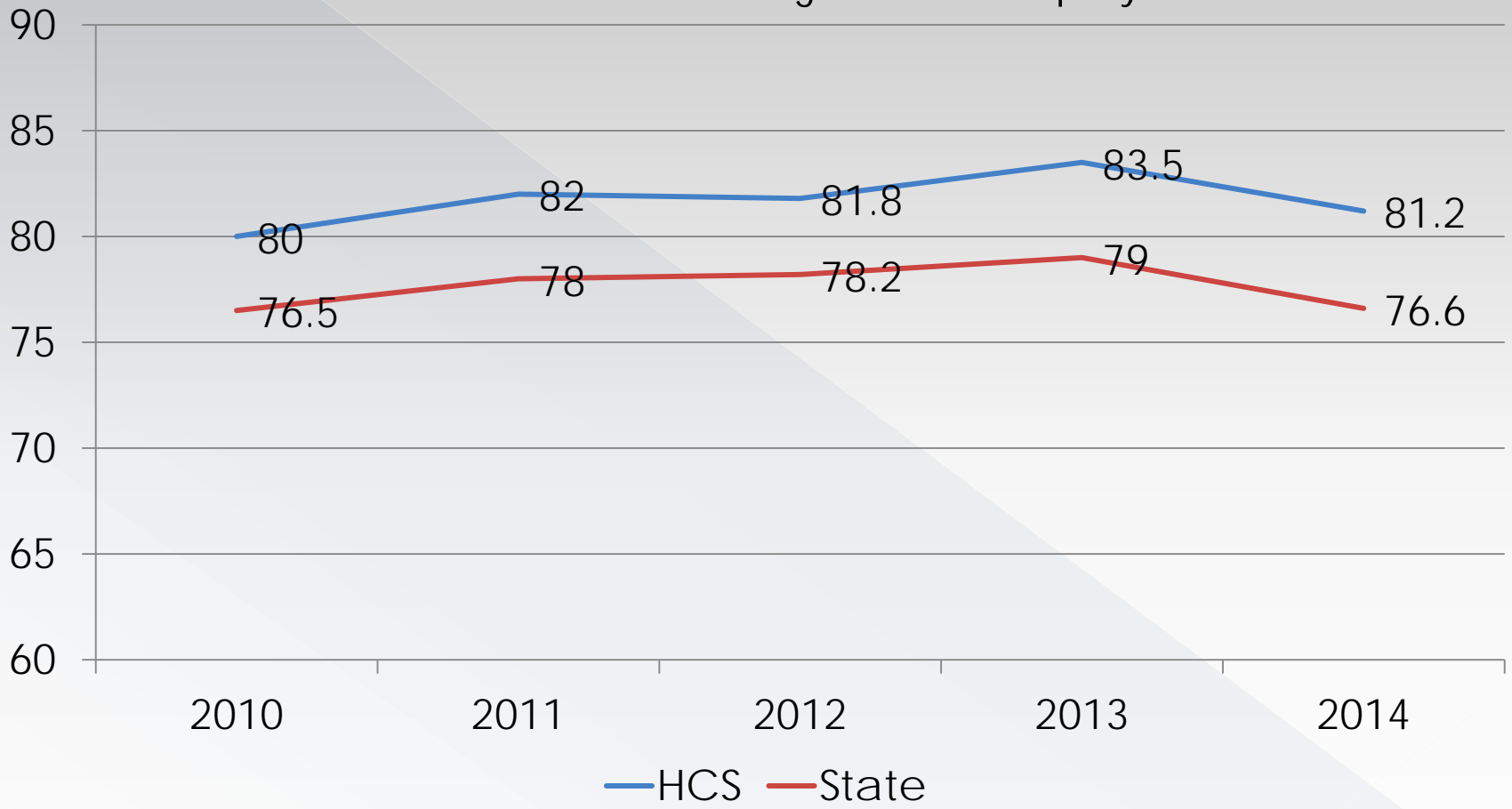

Grade 3: Percentage Met + Exemplary



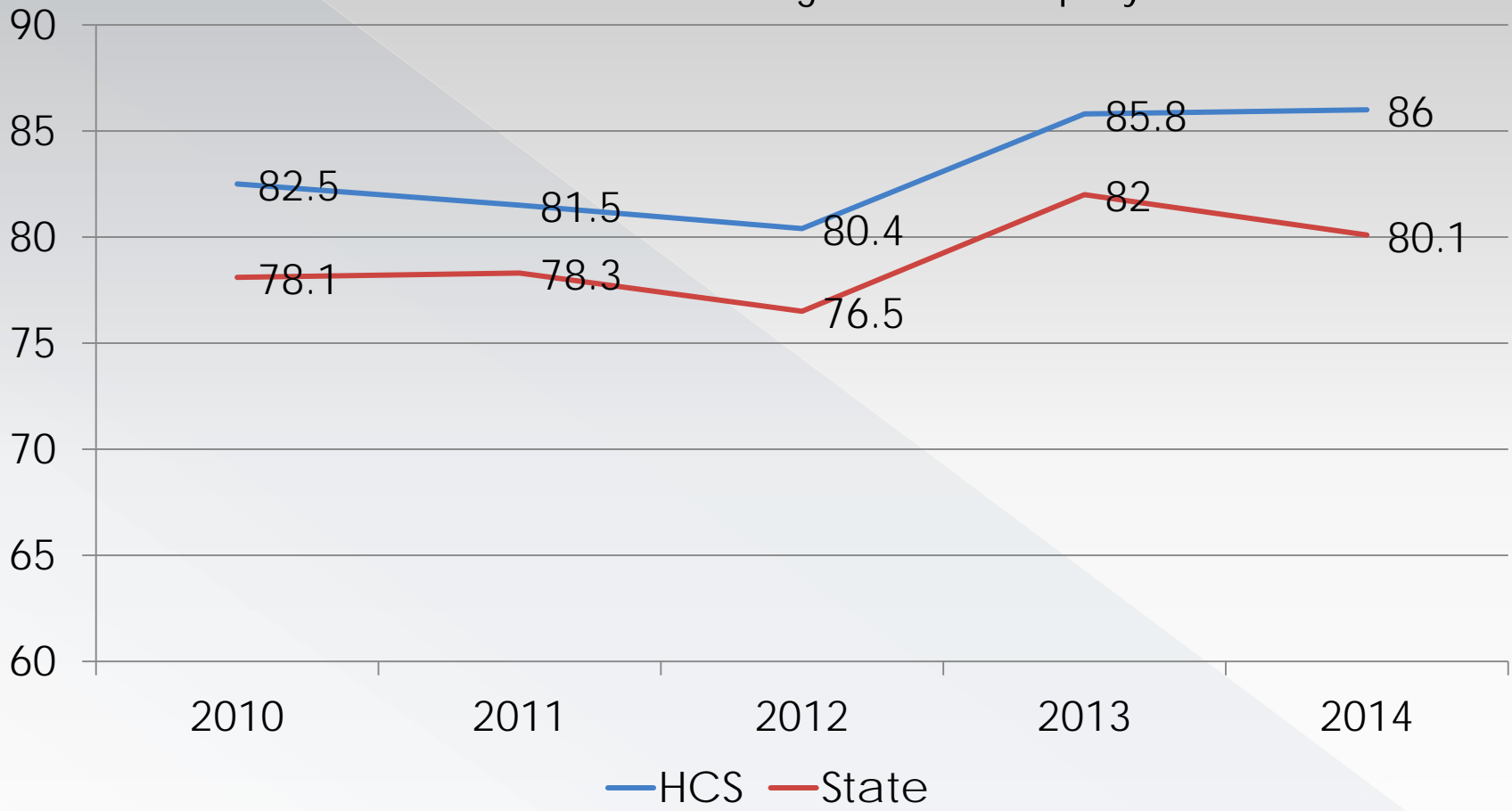

Grade 4: Percentage Met + Exemplary



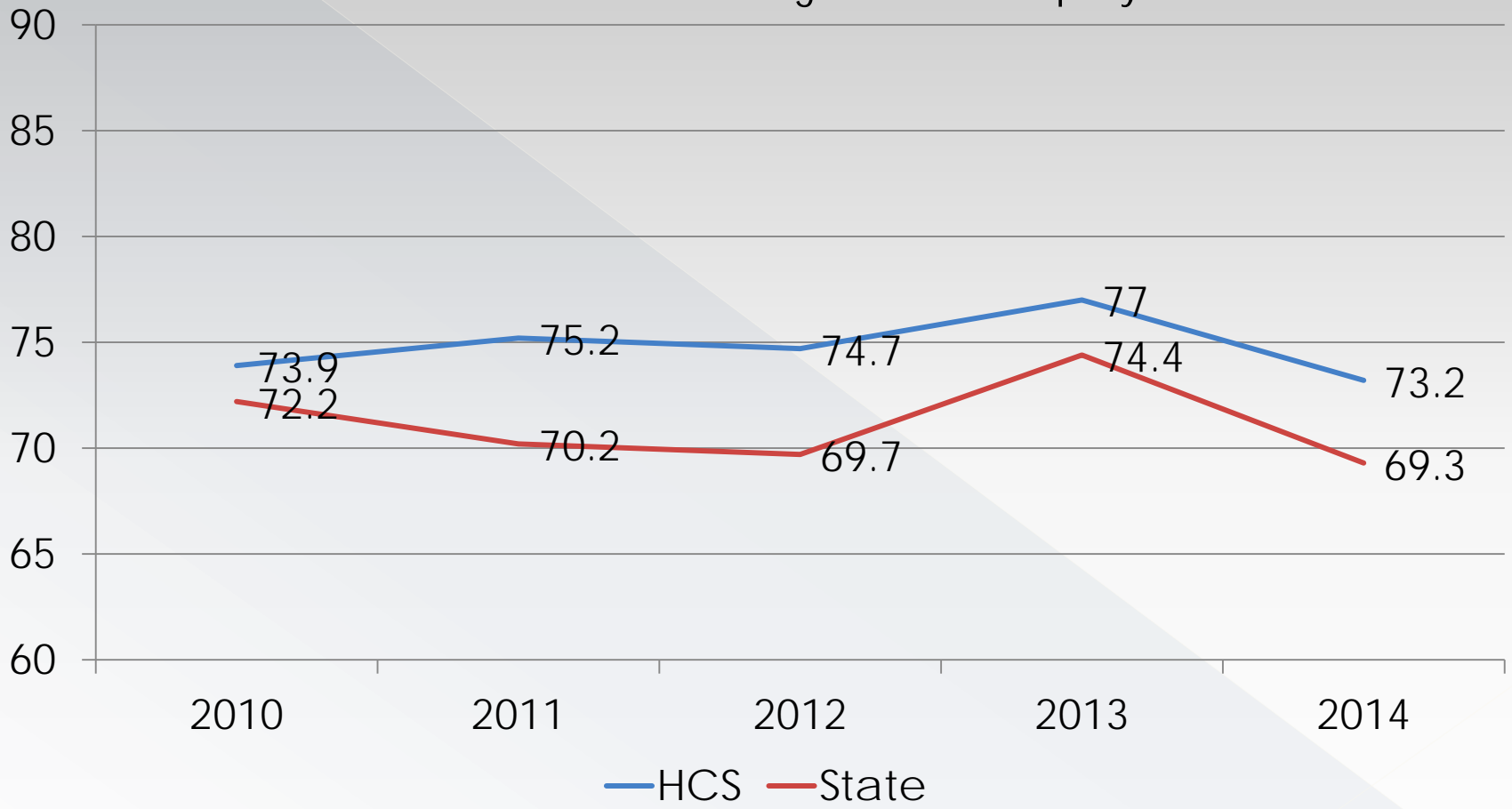

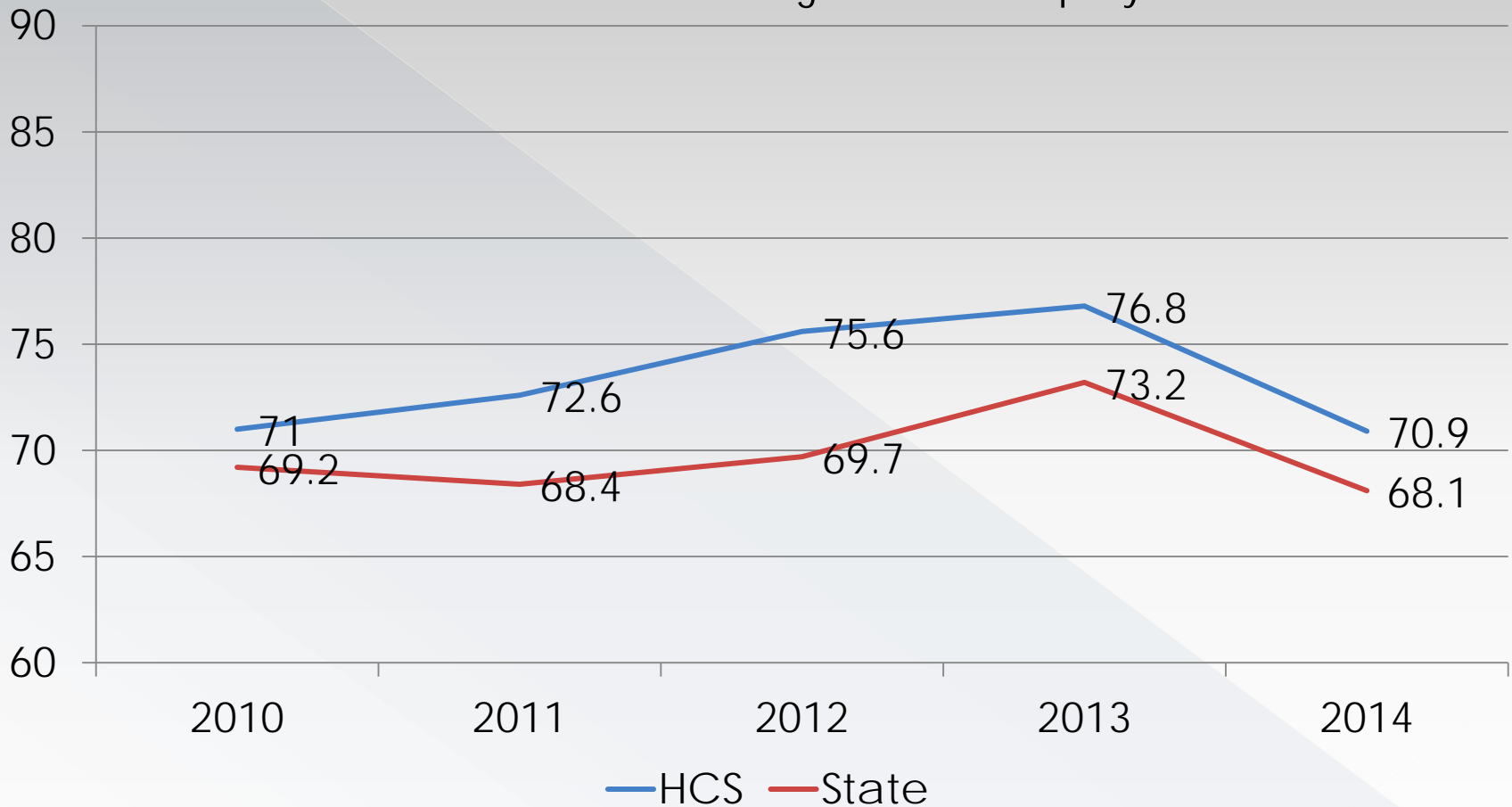

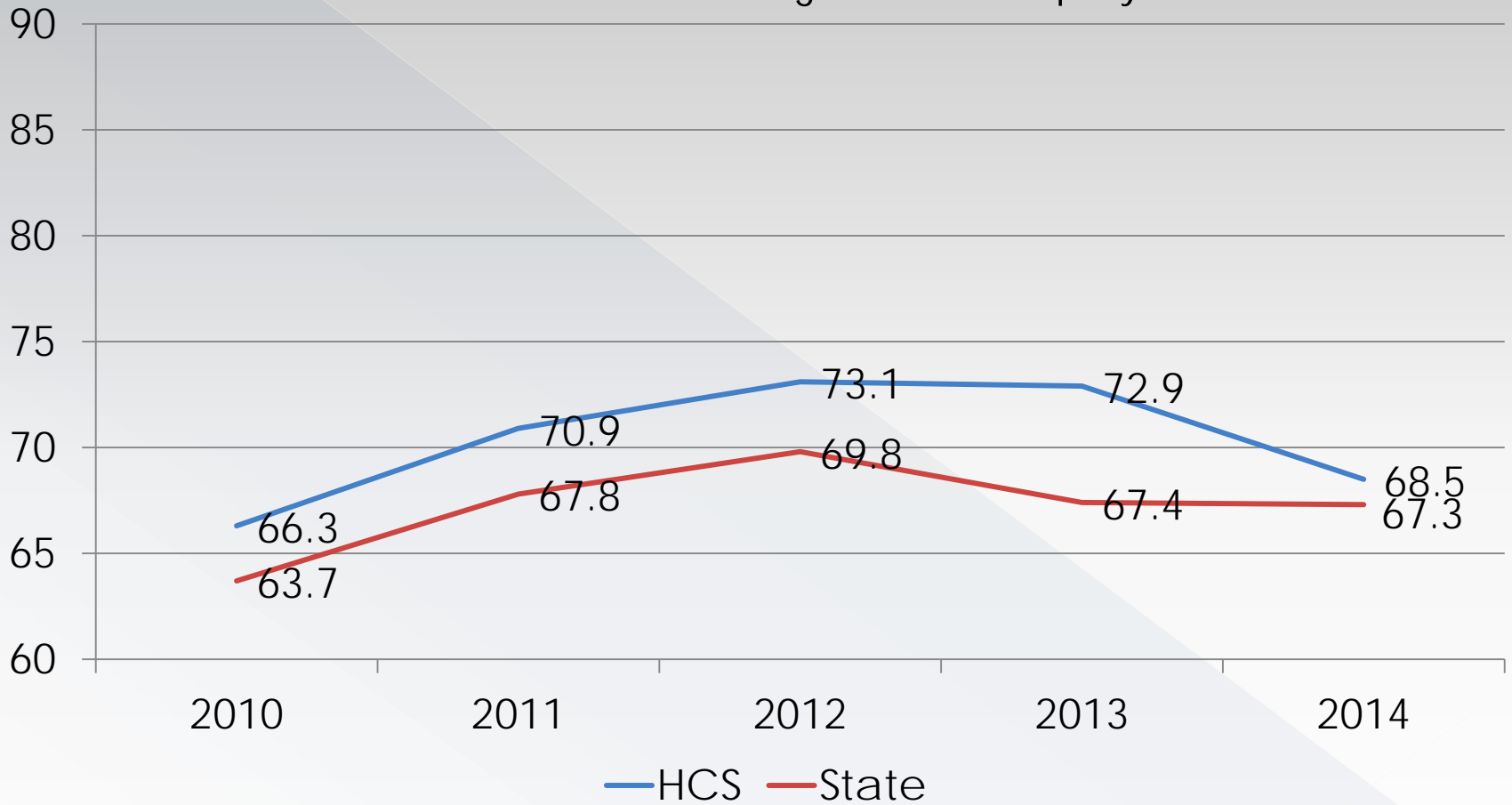

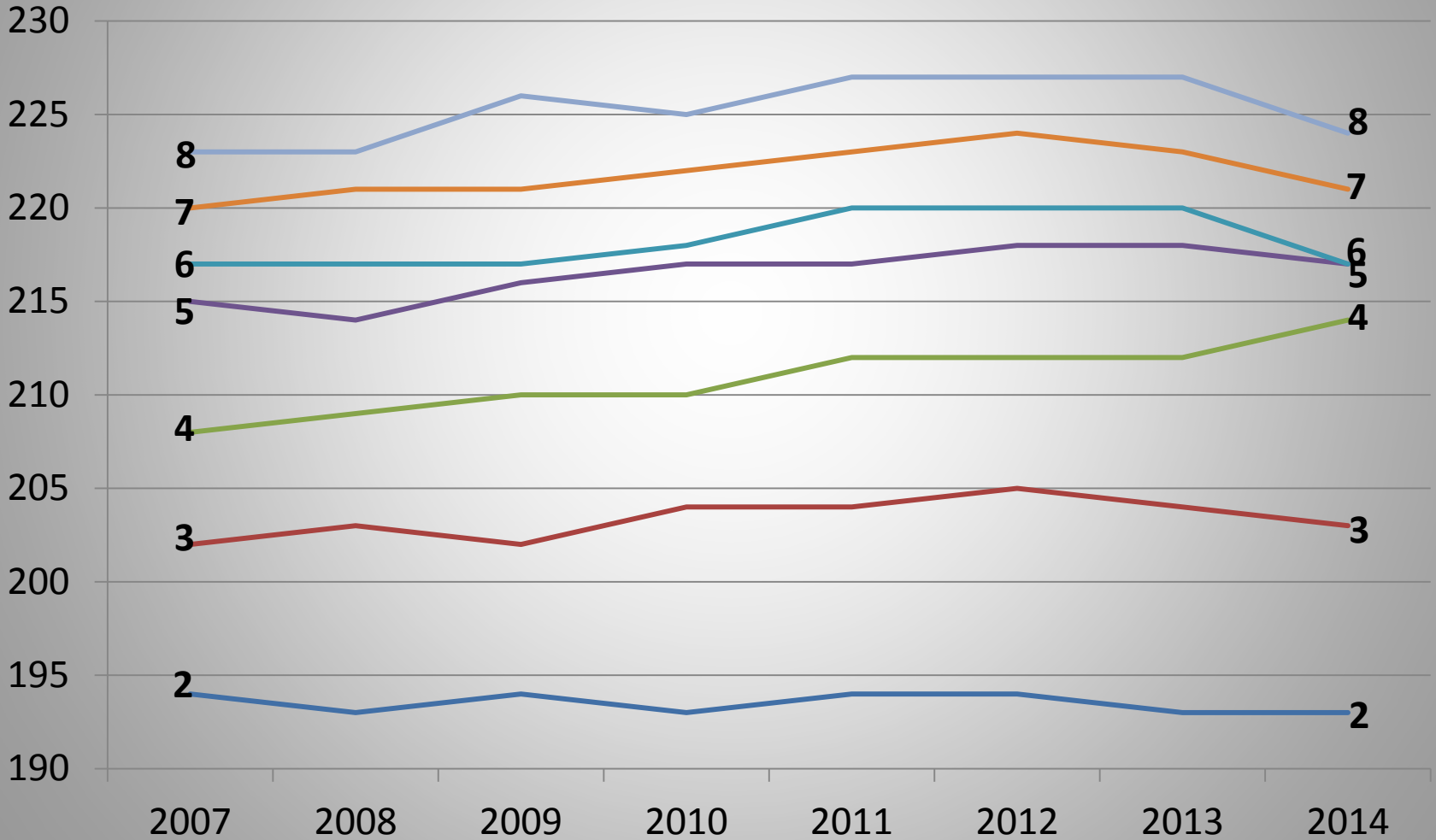

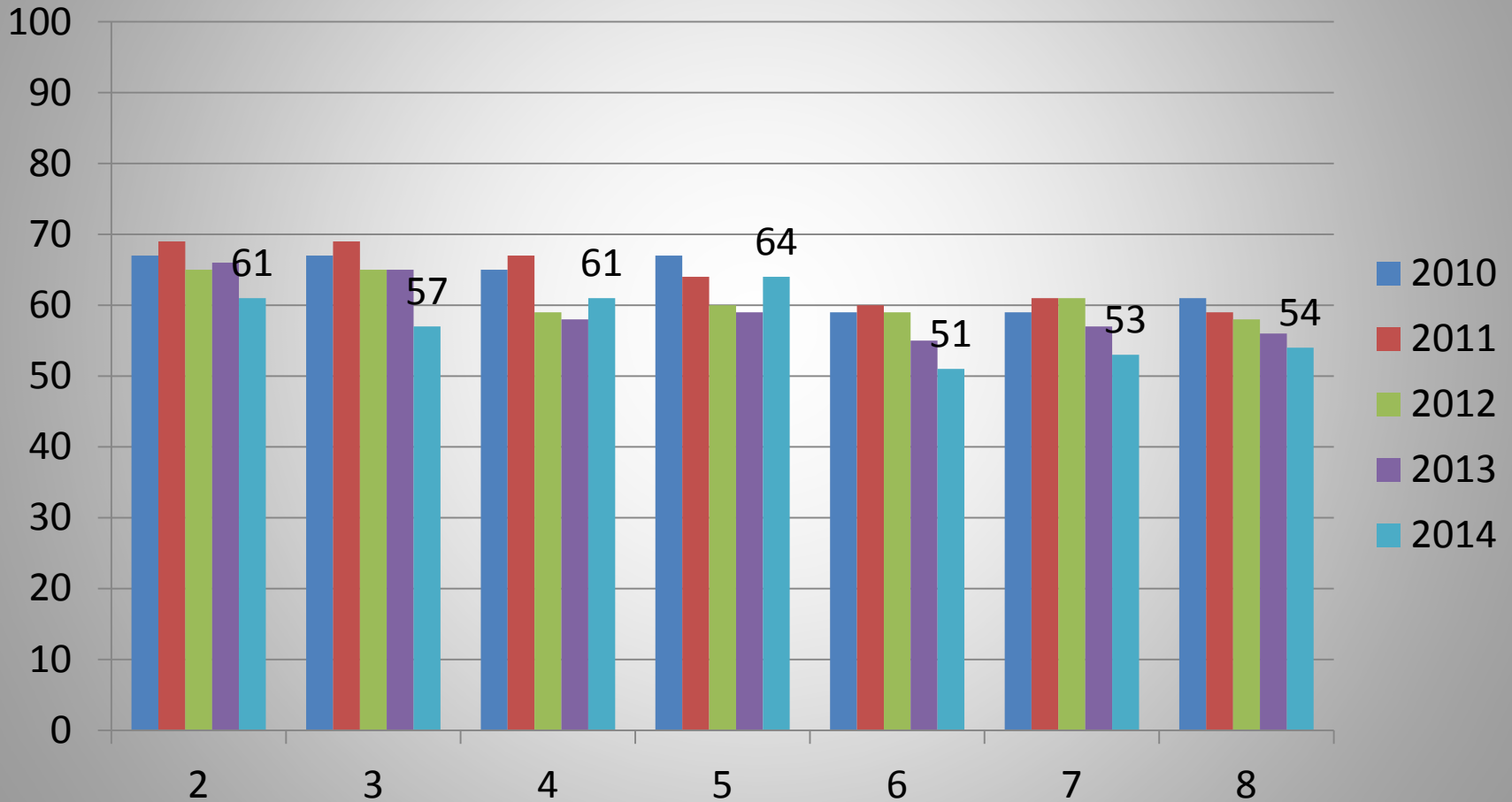
MAP Reading Scores Over Time

Spring Median RIT



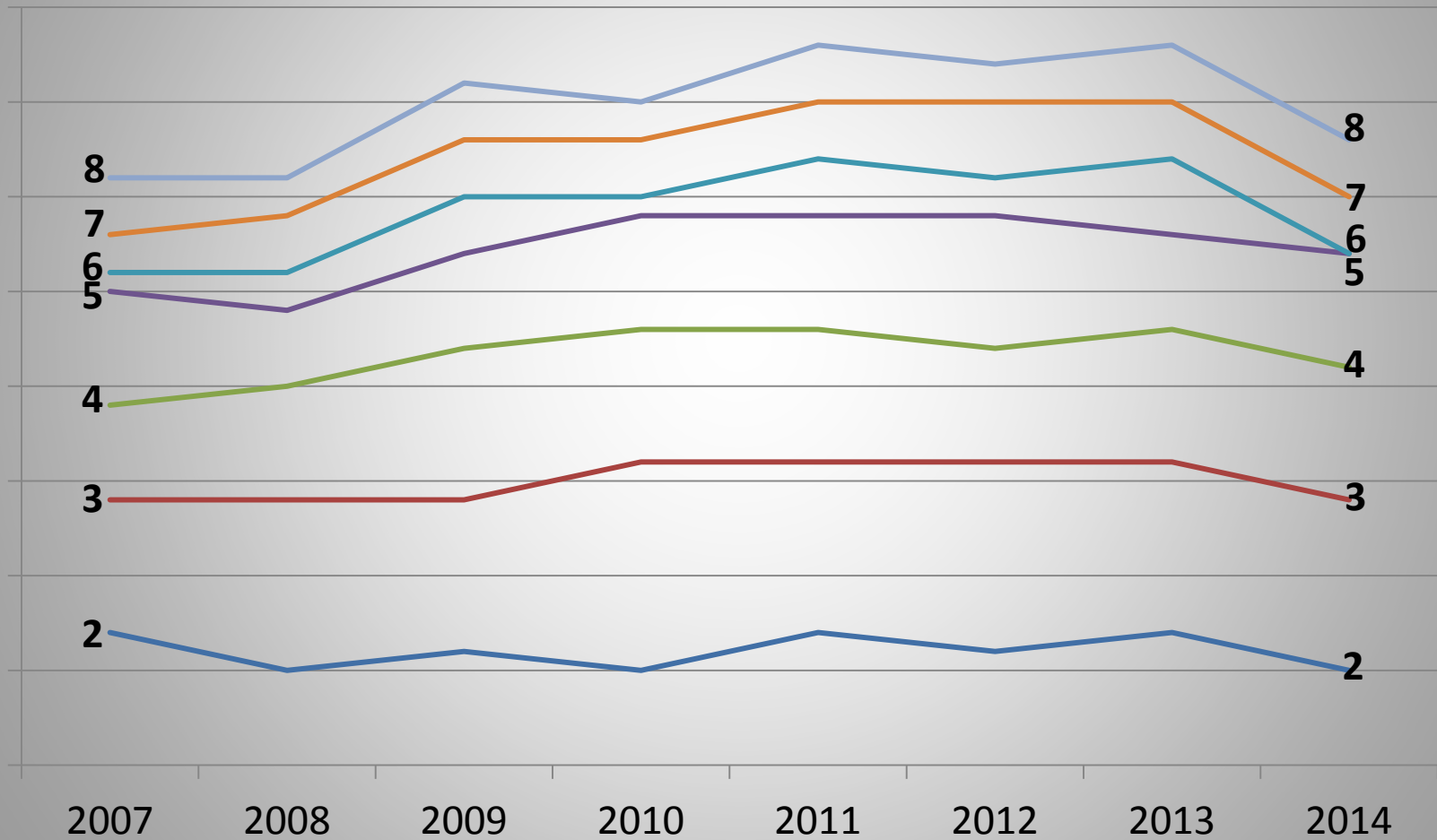
MAP Reading Growth Goals

MAP Language Scores Over Time

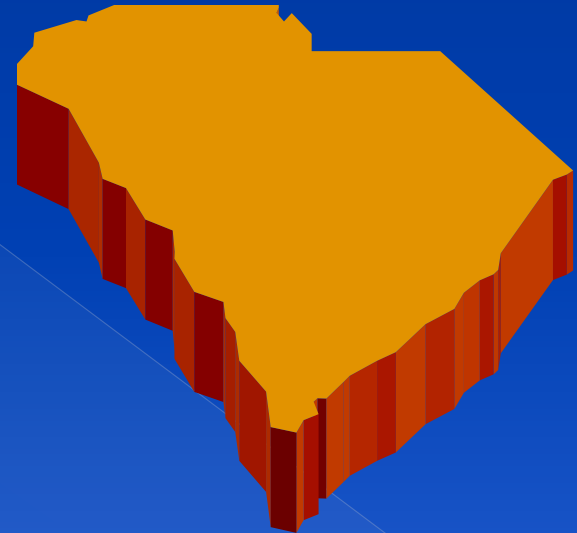

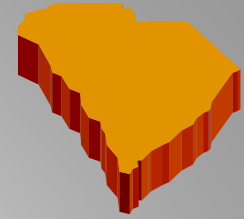

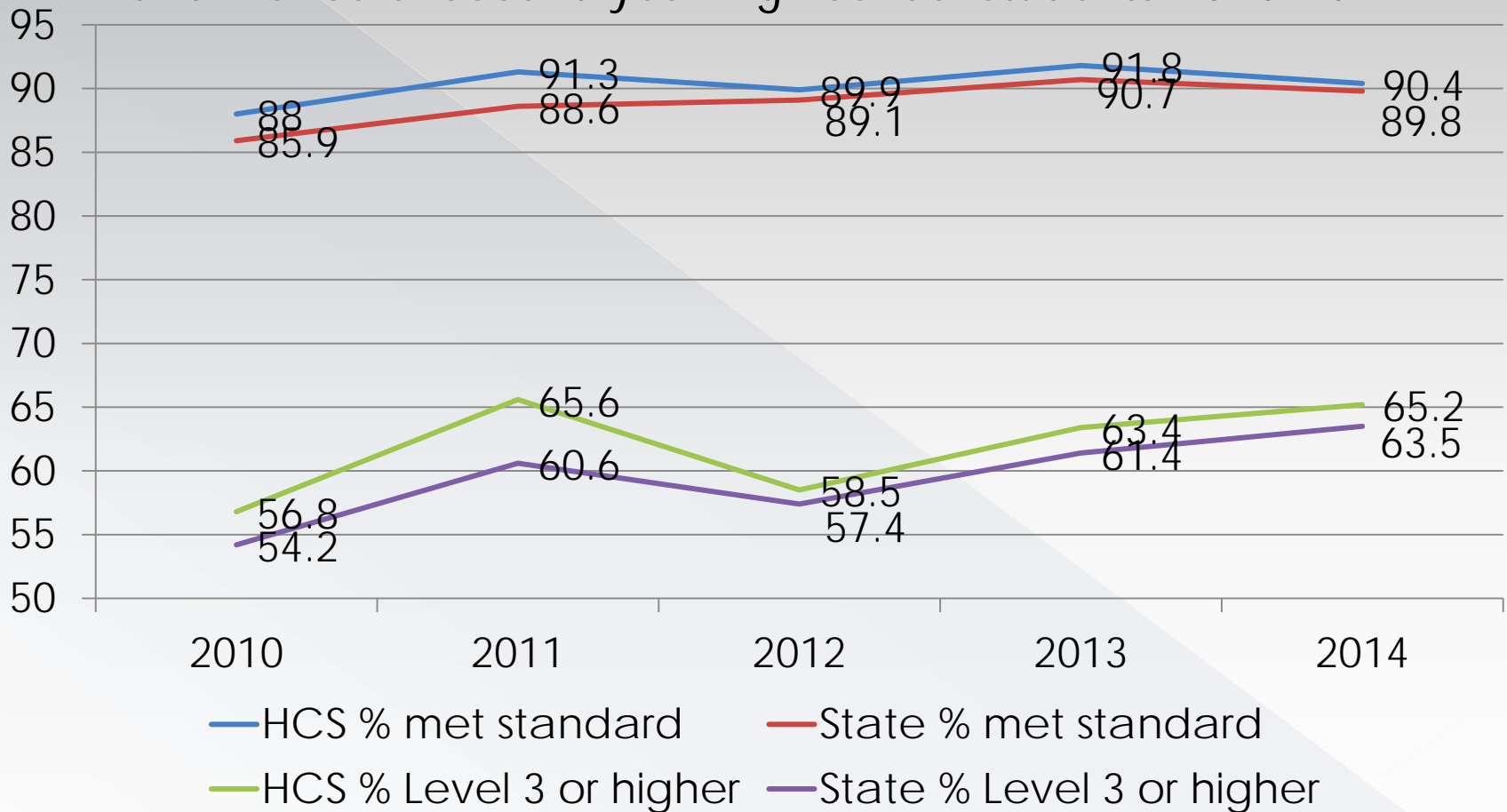

Performance of second year high school students 2010-2014

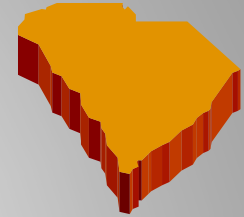

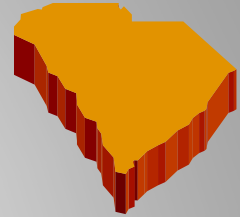

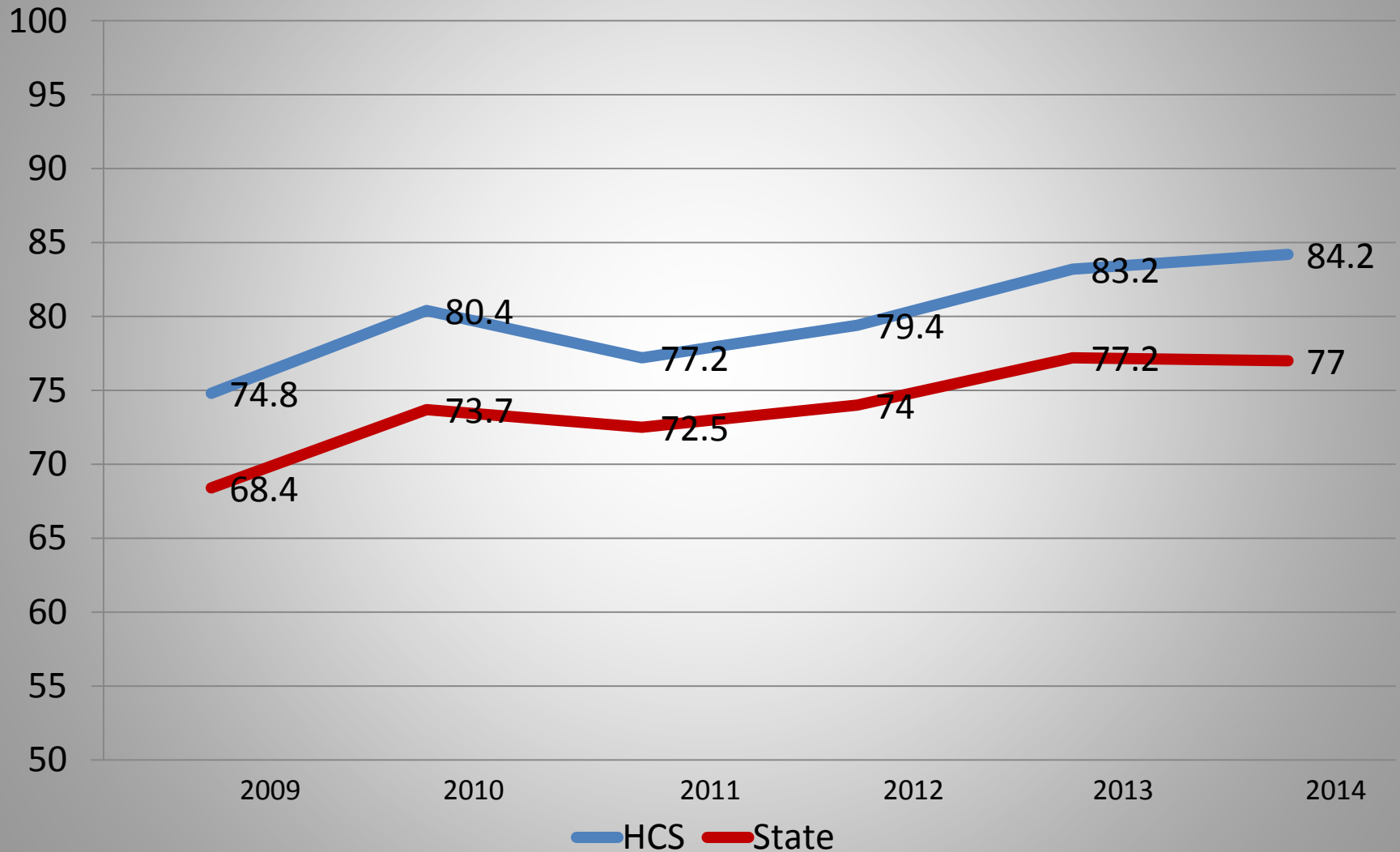

% Passing



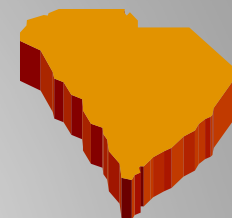
