The following firms have been ranked with the highest scores, and further consideration by Horry County Schools to provide Architectural Design Services for K-12 Building Modifications is requested:

- 3. Pike McFarland Hall Associates, Inc.
- 4. Quackenbush Architects & Planners, Inc.
- 5. SGA Architecture, LLC

The above listed firms' evaluation scores and rankings reflect the District's emphasis on Prior Performance & Related Experience on Similar Projects. Interviews will be scheduled for Thursday, December 11, 2014 at the Horry County Schools Facilities Department located at 1160 E Hwy. 501 in Conway, SC. Specific times for each interview will be provided no later than Tuesday, December 2nd.

We appreciate all efforts that were made to supply Horry County Schools with qualifications for this type of service. The protest shall be in accordance with the District's Procurement Code.
