

## **Horry County Community Cleanup Event**

### **Policy Reference:**

**Background Information:** On November 8, 2014, Horry County Council and Keep Horry County Beautiful will sponsor the largest litter cleanup event that has ever been organized in Horry County. Organizers, who anticipate that 1,000 volunteers will take part in this effort, will establish gathering locations for volunteers in each of the 11 County Council districts. From these predetermined locations, volunteers will be transported to litter pick-up locations.

On Monday, October 13, 2014, Mark Lazarus, Chairman, Horry County Council, appeared before the Horry County School Board to request that Horry County Schools provide school buses and drivers in order to transport volunteers from staging areas to pick-up locations and to return the volunteers to their points of origin once the event has concluded.

### **Recommended Action:**

**Estimated Project Cost:** 1 Driver @ \$30.95 per hour (includes fringe and overtime pay) multiplied by a minimum of 5 hours equals \$154.75 for each driver who participates in the event. Therefore, for 5 hours work, 6 drivers would cost approximately \$928.50. In addition, vehicle cost is \$1.86 per mile.
