SURVEY: Areas of strongest agreement

TEACHERS

99% Teachers effectively impact State curriculum standards.

98% My school offers a challenging instructional program for students.

98% I feel safe going to or coming from my school.

98% I feel safe at school during the day.

98% I feel safe at school before and after hours.

99% Teachers expect students to learn.

98% Teachers expect students to behave.

96% Teachers test what I learn in class.

95% Parents are welcome at my school.

95% My parents know how well I'm doing in school.

93% I use computers and technology to help me learn.

91% I feel safe at school during the day.

93% Teachers encourage children to learn.

SURVEY: Areas of lowest agreement

TEACHERS

74% Parents volunteer in the classroom and at school. (*Up 1.9*)

80% Level of teacher morale is high. (*Up 0.3*)

83% Parents attend school meetings and events. (*Up 0.3*)

85% Teachers are recognized and appreciated for good work. (*Down 4.4*)

86% Parents are interested in their children's schoolwork. (*Up 0.9*)

STUDENTS

53% Students behave in the hallways, lunchroom and on school grounds. (*Up 0.5*)

53% Students behave in class. (*No change*)

54% School bathrooms are kept clean. (*No change*)

48% Child's teacher invites me to visit classroom during the day. (*Up 1.6*)

61% Child's teacher contacts me to say good things about child. (*Up 0.9*)

66% Child's teacher tells me how I can help my child learn. (*Down 0.4*)

SURVEY: Areas of most improvement in Strongly Agree/Agree

TEACHERS

+3.5% School has sufficient computers for instruction. **(90.7% agree)**

+2.5% Parents are involved in school decisions through advisory committees. **(89.9% agree)**

+2.4% Students know rules and what happens when they break rules. **(86.9% agree)**

+2.2% I am satisfied with the social and physical environment. **(95.3% agree)**

+1.4% School administration communicates clear instructional goals. **(93.1% agree)**

STUDENTS

+3.8% Grounds around school are kept clean. **(83% agree)**

+2.8% I feel safe at school before and after hours. **(89.9% agree)**

+2.4% Students know rules and what happens when they break rules. **(91.2% agree)**

+1.9% I use computers and technology at school to help me learn. **(93% agree)**

+1.9% Rules about student behavior are fair. **(82.7% agree)**

PARENTS

+4.4% Child's teacher invites me to visit classroom during the day. **(52.8% agree)**

+2.0% Child's school involves me in decision making. **(69.9% agree)**

+1.6% Child's teacher invites me to visit child's classroom during the day. **(48.1% agree)**

SURVEY: Areas of most decline in Strongly Agree/Agree

TEACHERS

-4.4% Teachers are recognized and appreciated for good work. **(85.5% agree)**

No other areas more than -1.0.

STUDENTS

-5.4% Work done by students can be seen on walls of school. **(81.8% agree)**

-4.4% Textbooks and workbooks really help me learn. **(69.8% agree)**

-1.1% Teachers praise students who do good work. **(80.4% agree)**

PARENTS

-11.6% I am satisfied with home-school relations. **(72.2% agree; but “don’t know” increased by 10.7%)**

-3.9% Child’s school gives me information about what child should be learning in school. **(73.8% agree)**

-1.5% School schedules activities when I can attend. **(77.2% agree)**

Additional Parent Survey Items

OVERALL DISTRICT RESULTS:

- 59% said work schedule makes it hard to be involved.
- School's overall friendliness: 84% Very Good/Good (up 2.8%)
- How school is doing overall: 79% Very Good/Good (up 2.3%)
