

Carolina Forest Advisory Board

Policy Reference:

Act 754, Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of S.C., 1952, p. 1905 et seq., states, "The Horry County Board of Education may appoint advisory boards of trustees." The Horry County Board of Education shall determine the size of advisory boards. Each advisory board shall consist of a minimum of five members.

Background Information:

With the attendance line changes that will be implemented for the 2014-2015 school year, the Carolina Forest Attendance Area will be reduced to eight schools. This reduction is due to the loss of South Conway Elementary from the Carolina Forest Attendance Area. These eight schools are:
