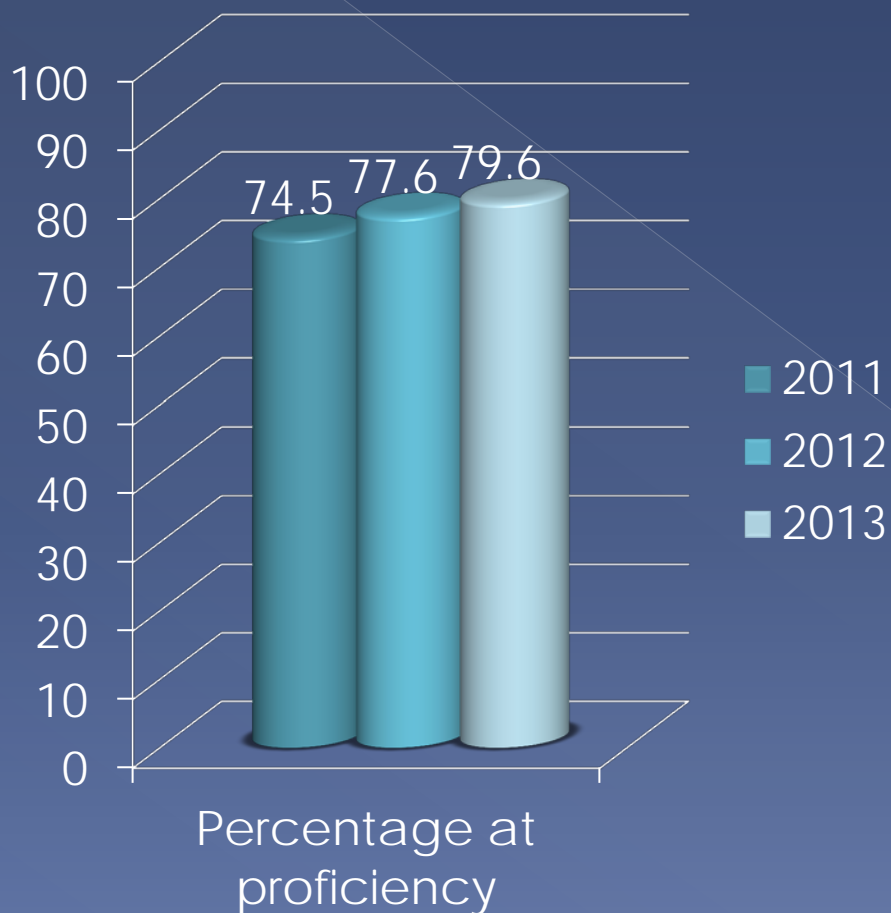
Proficiency level grades 3-HS

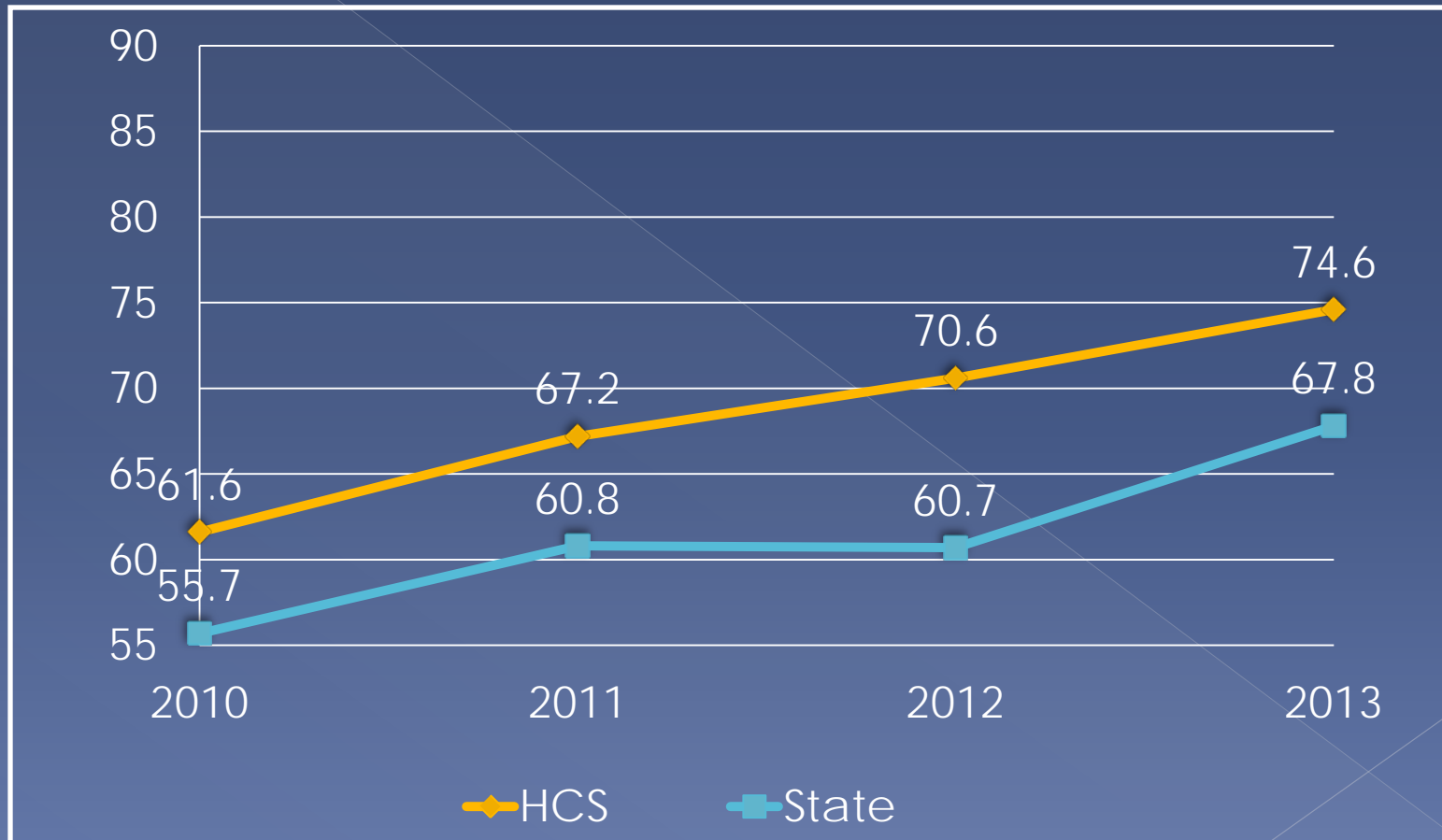

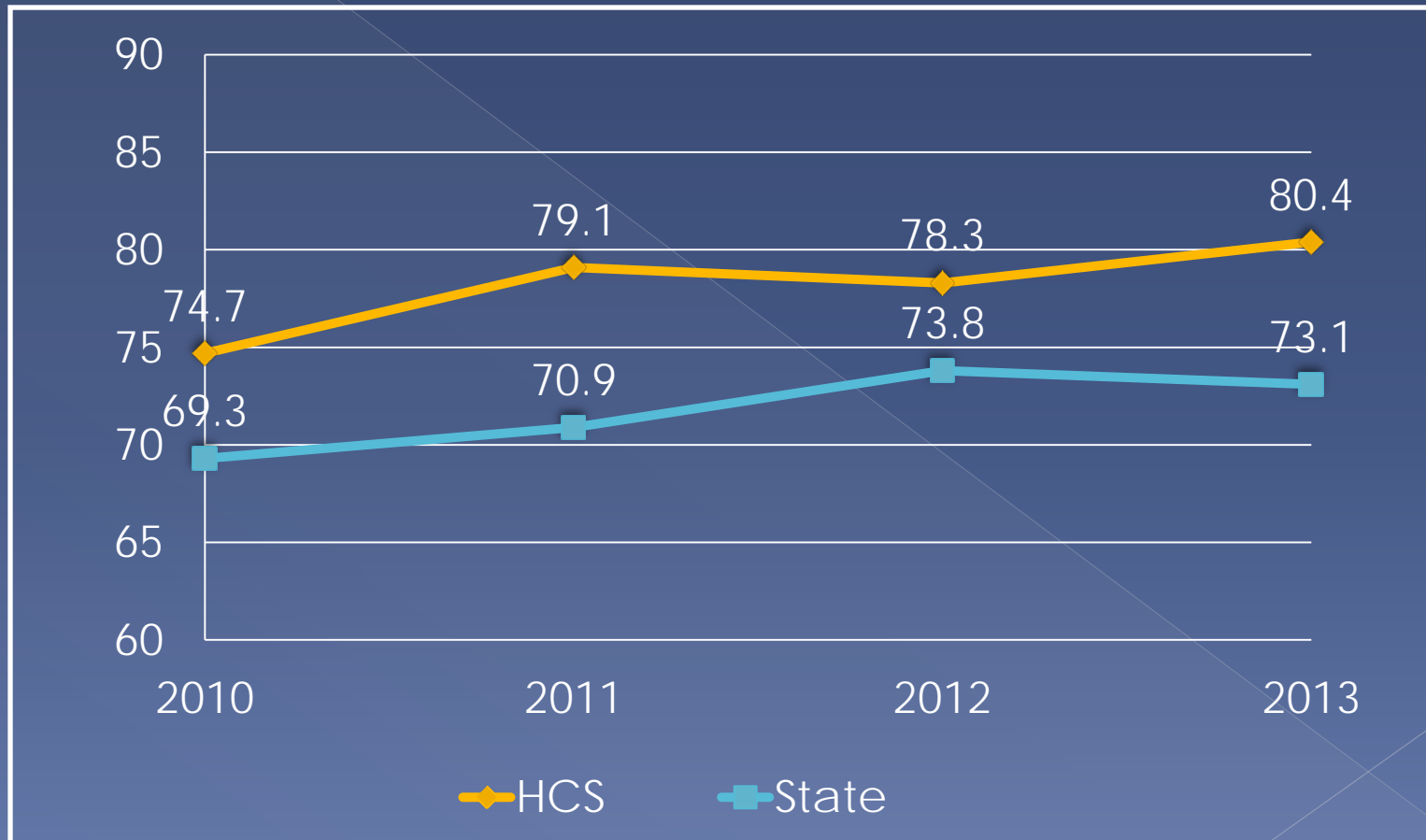

Grade 3: Percentage Met + Exemplary



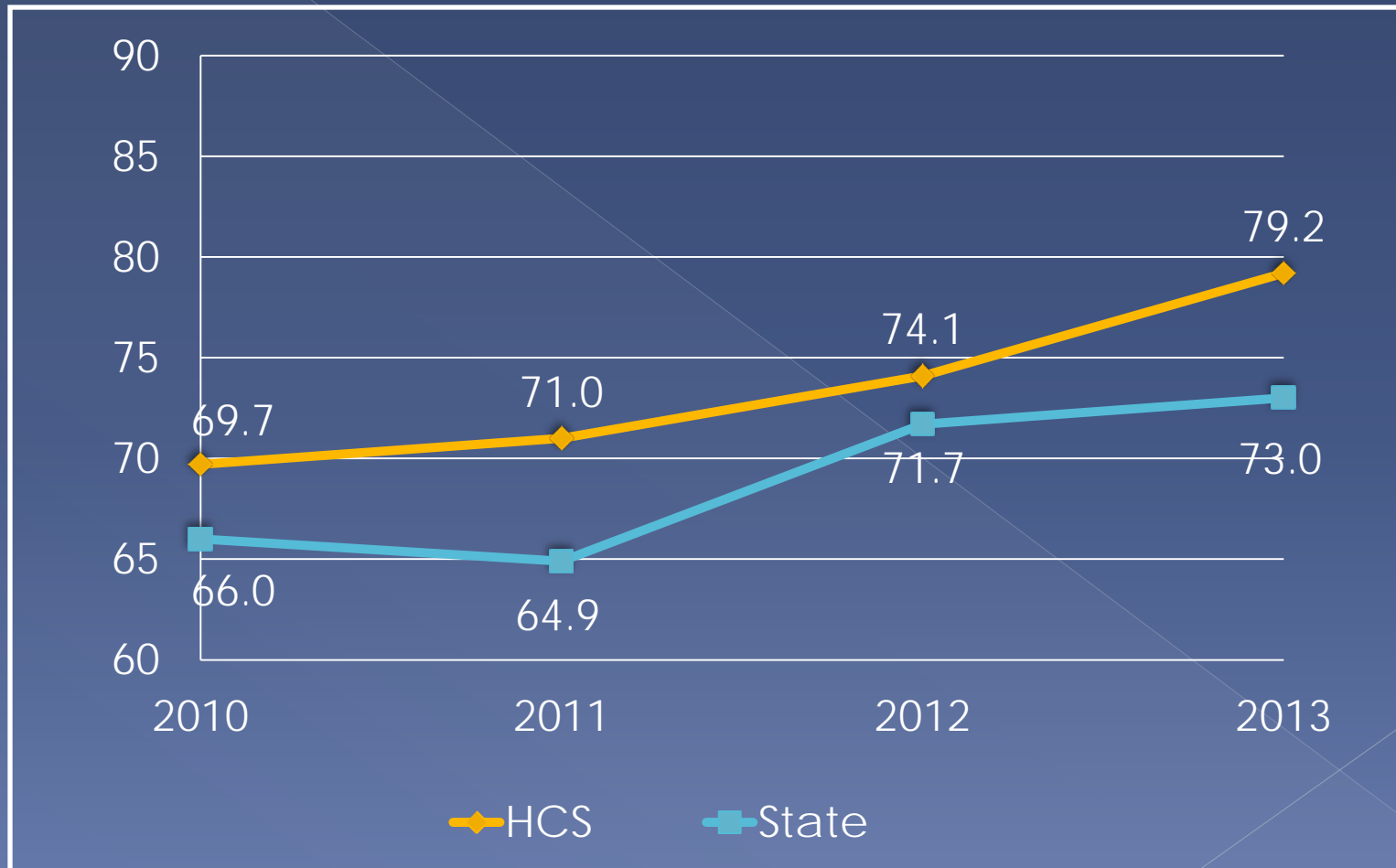

Grade 4: Percentage Met + Exemplary



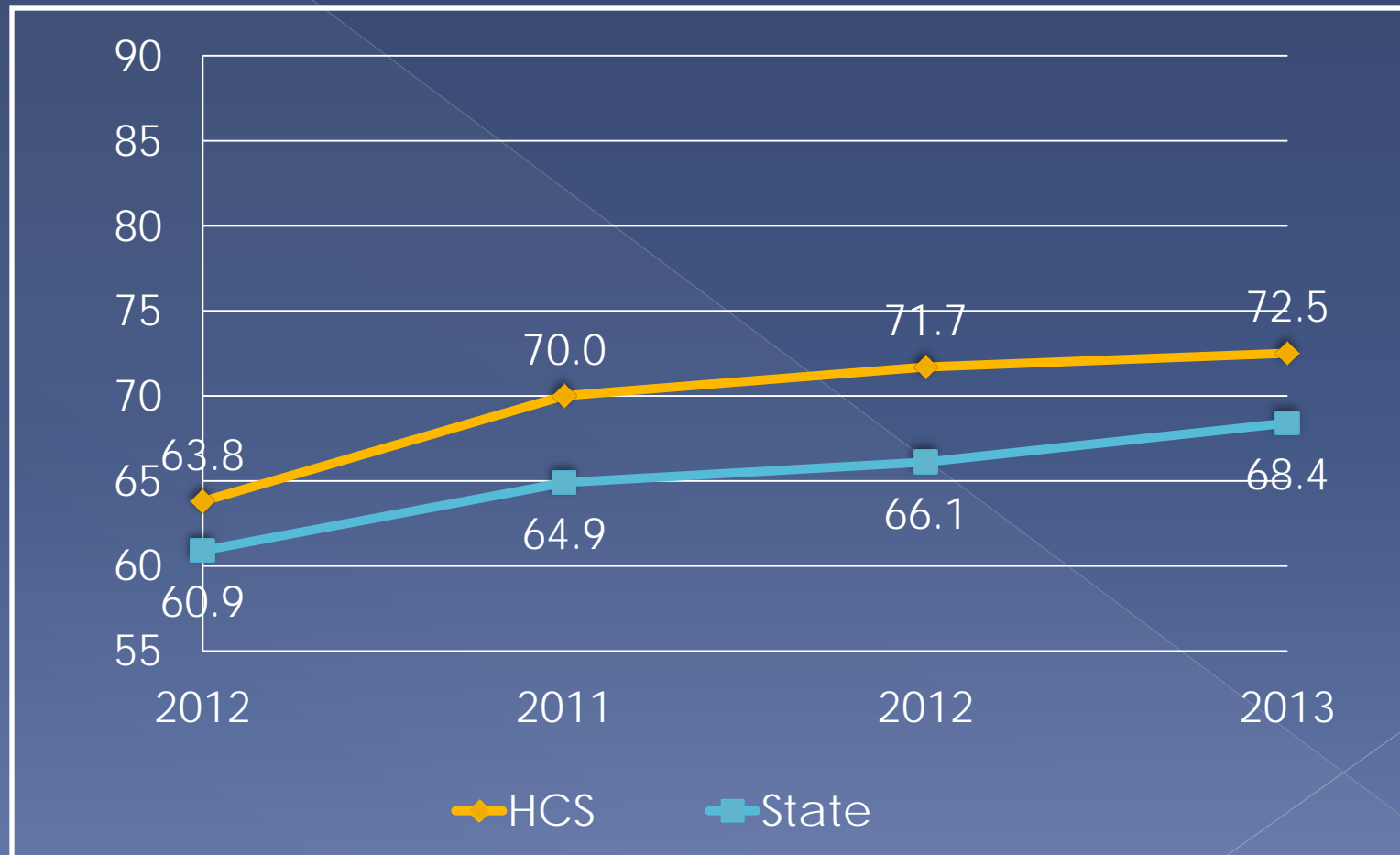

Grade 5: Percentage Met + Exemplary



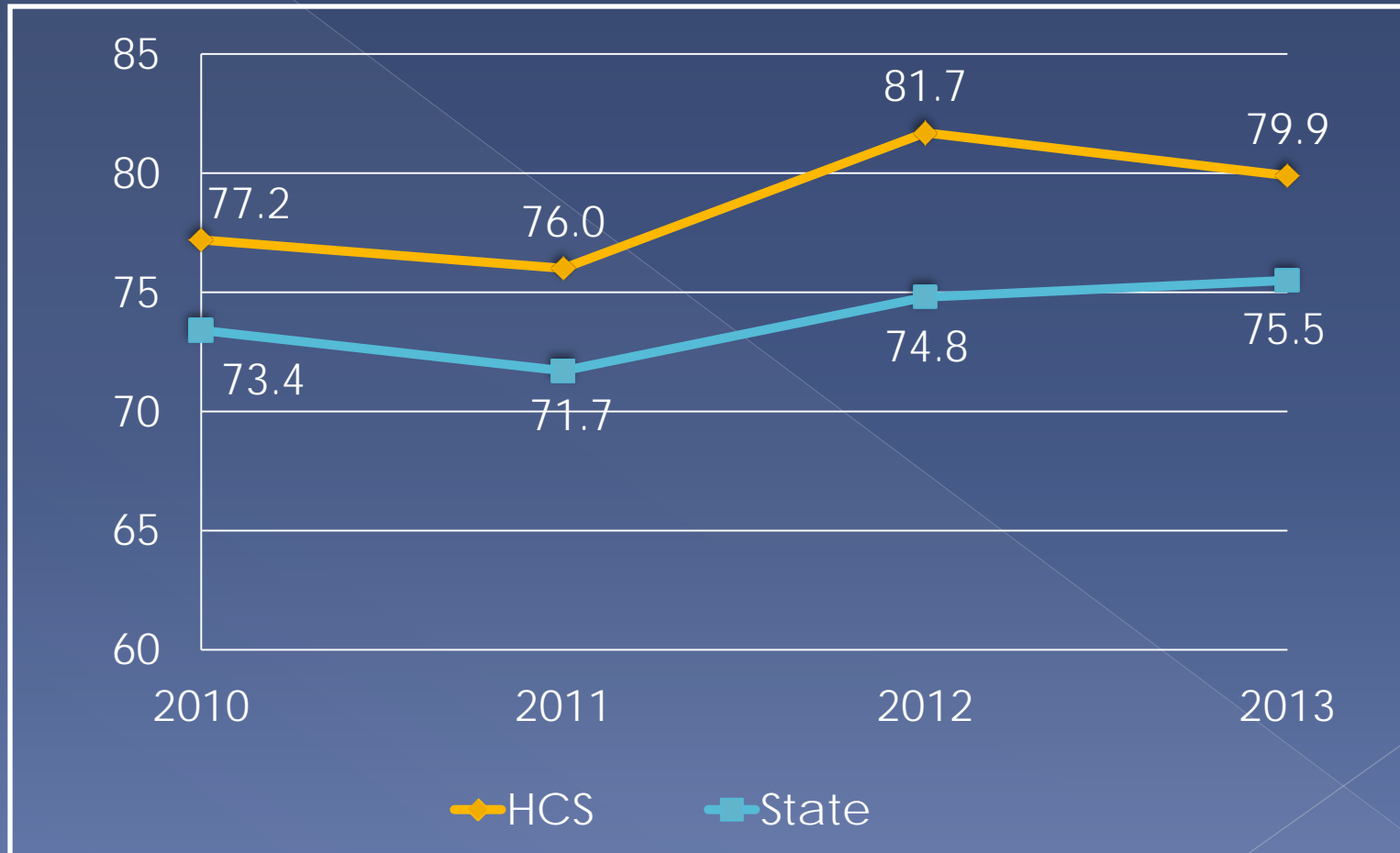

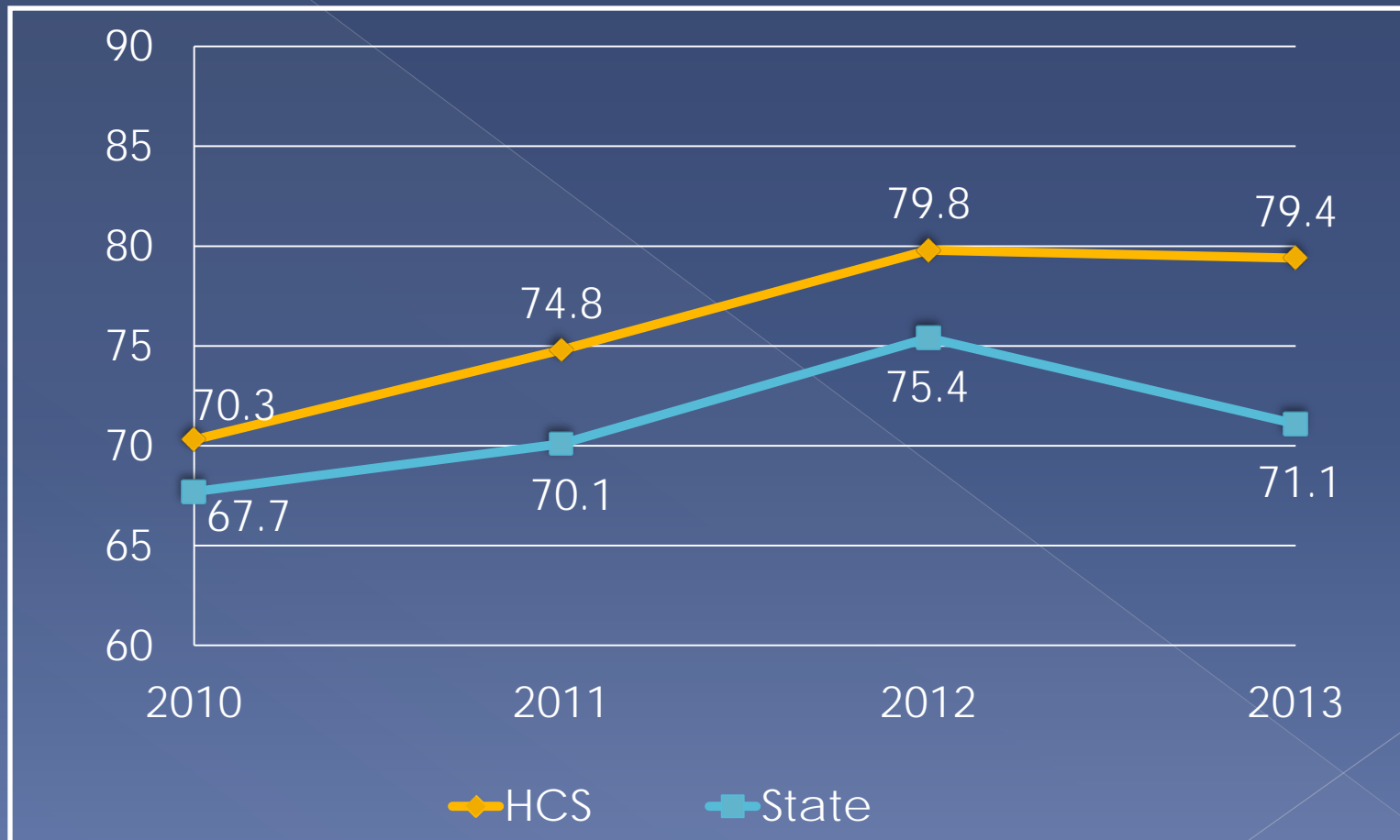

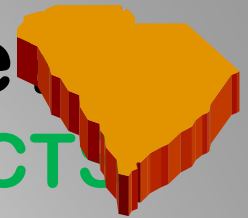

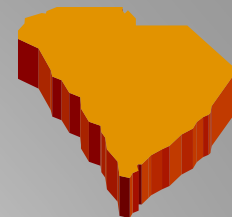

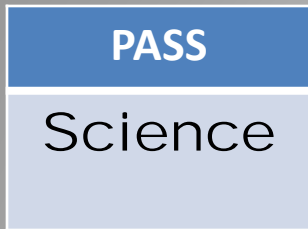

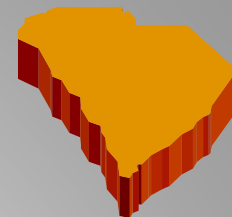

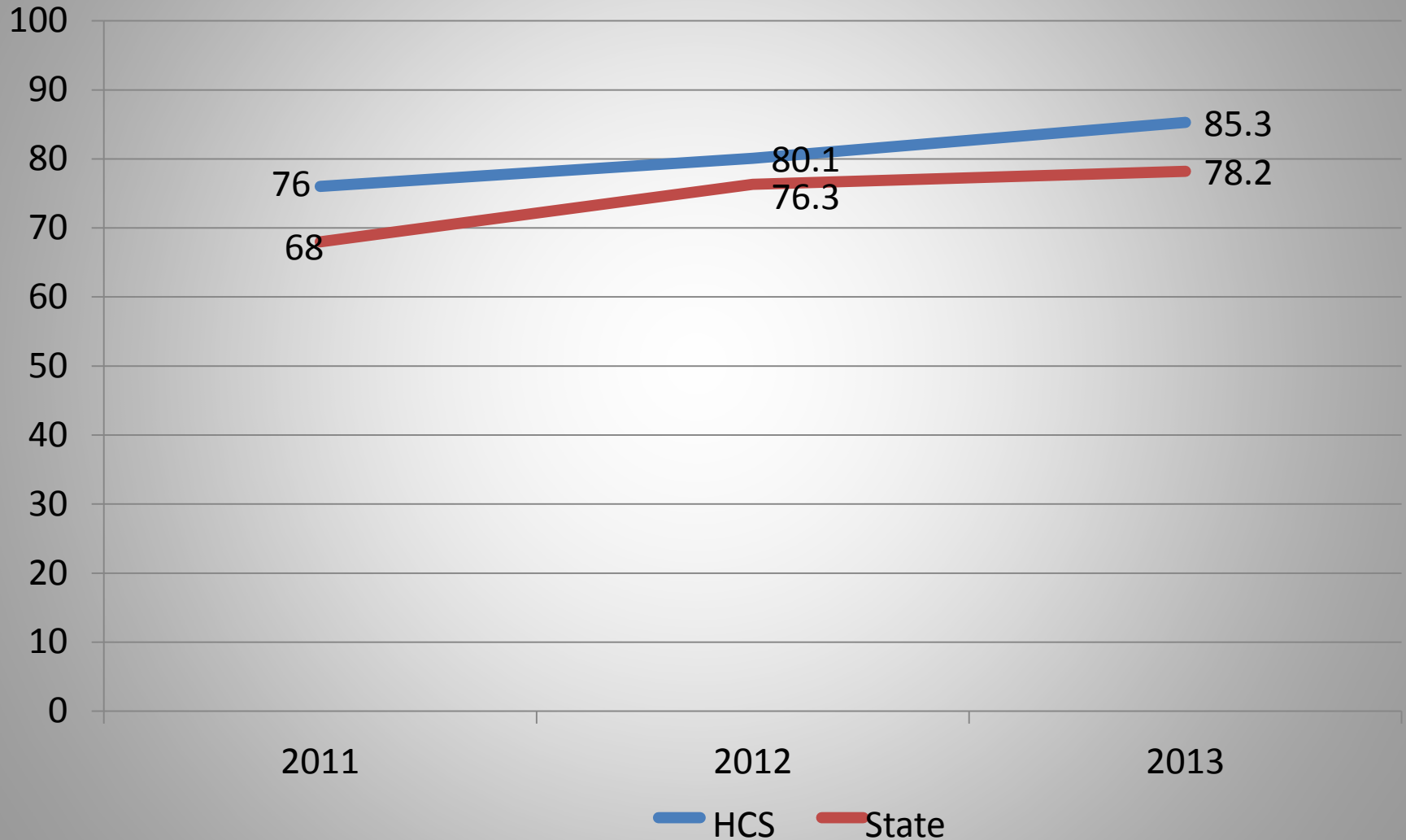

% Passing



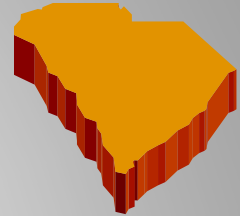
