Title: Revision of 2013-14 School Calendar

Policy Reference: OE-10; Instructional Program

Background Information: On March 12, 2014, Governor Haley signed into law HB. 4576 (Snow Days). The joint resolution allows local school boards to waive up to five days missed due to inclement weather. The district must exhaust all statutorily required make up days remaining on the calendar before it may exempt any of the five days allowed under the joint resolution.

Aynor and Green Sea Floyds attendance areas missed a total of seven days due to recent inclement weather. All other attendance areas missed a total of six days. February 17 was a designated Weather Day and was used as one make-up day and March 28 is the second Weather Day remaining that will also be used as a make-up day.

<u>Purpose</u>: To exercise the right to waive up to five school days missed due to inclement weather.
