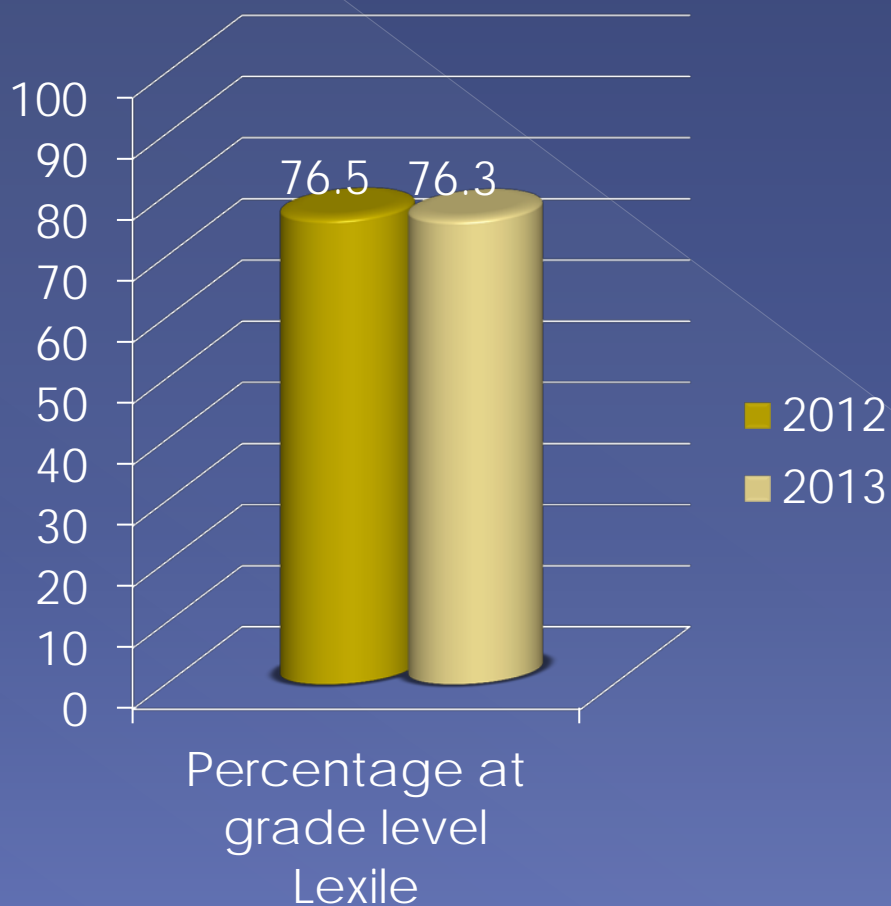
Second grade reading level

- **MEASURE:** MAP Reading (Spring) Lexile range for grade 2; percentage of students reading within expected Lexile range

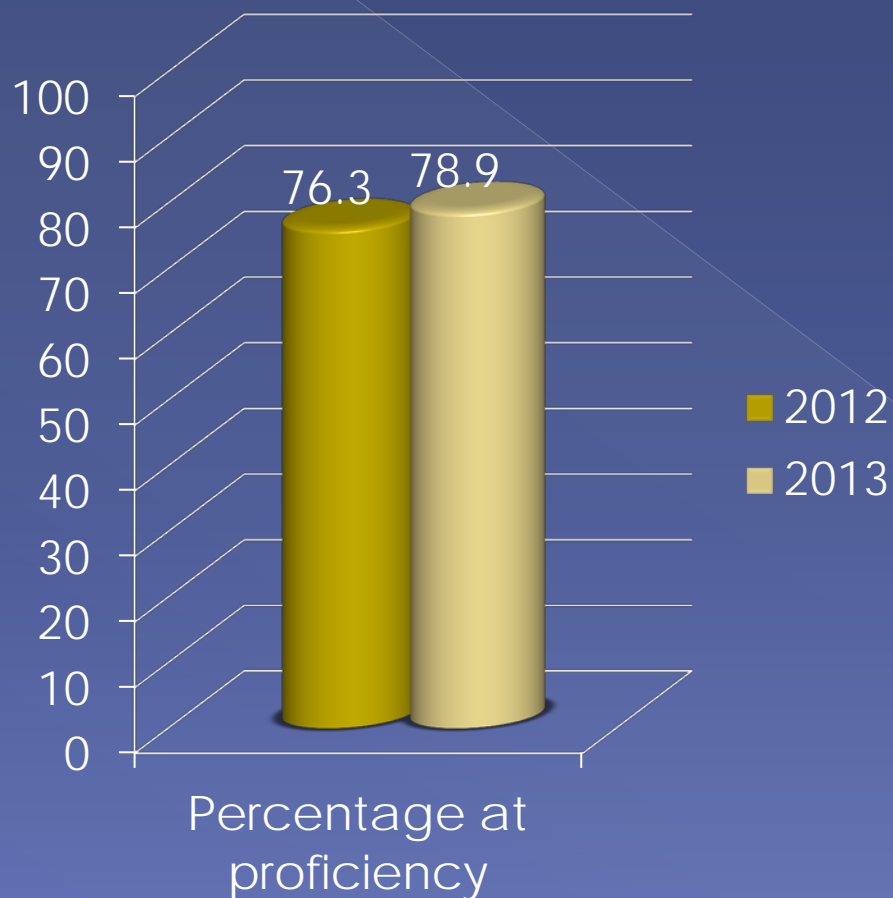
Proficiency level grades 3-HS

Power Goal 2: Reading/ELA

Increase the percentage of students in grades 3-HS who score at proficiency/passing level

- **MEASURES:** Aggregated percentage scoring Met or higher on PASS Reading in grades 3-8, Level 3 or higher on HSAP English Language Arts, and passing English I end-of-course test

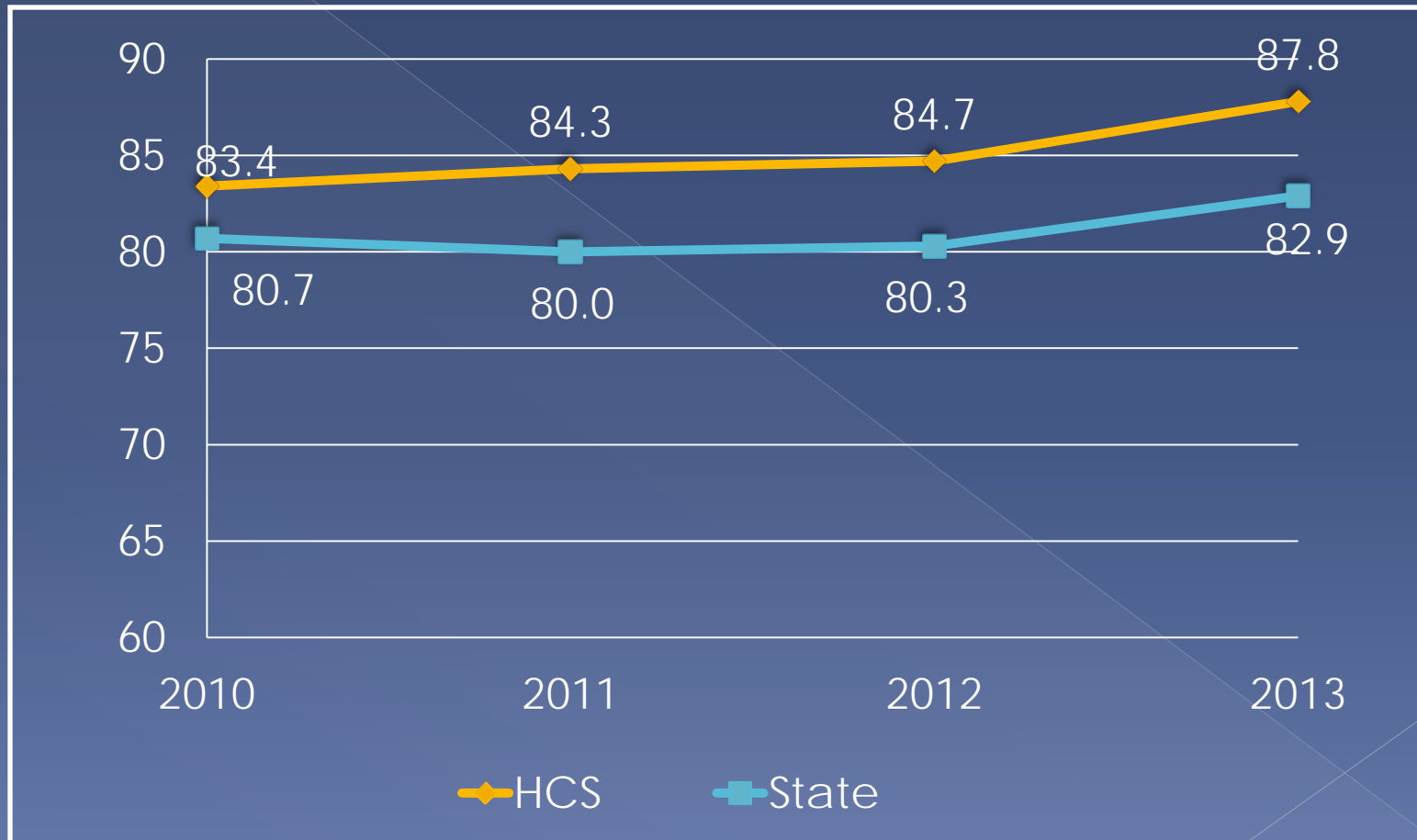

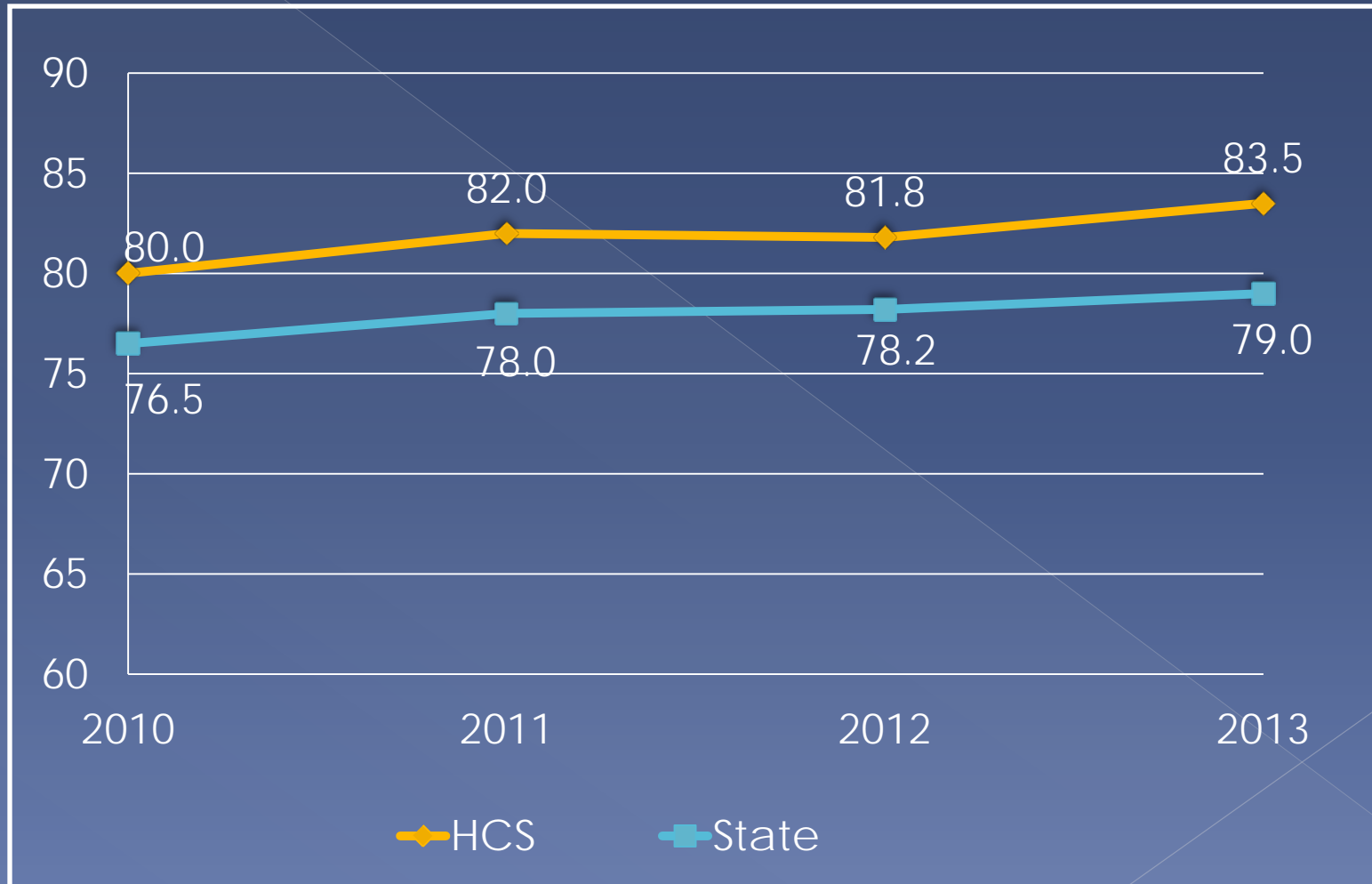

Grade 3: Percentage Met + Exemplary



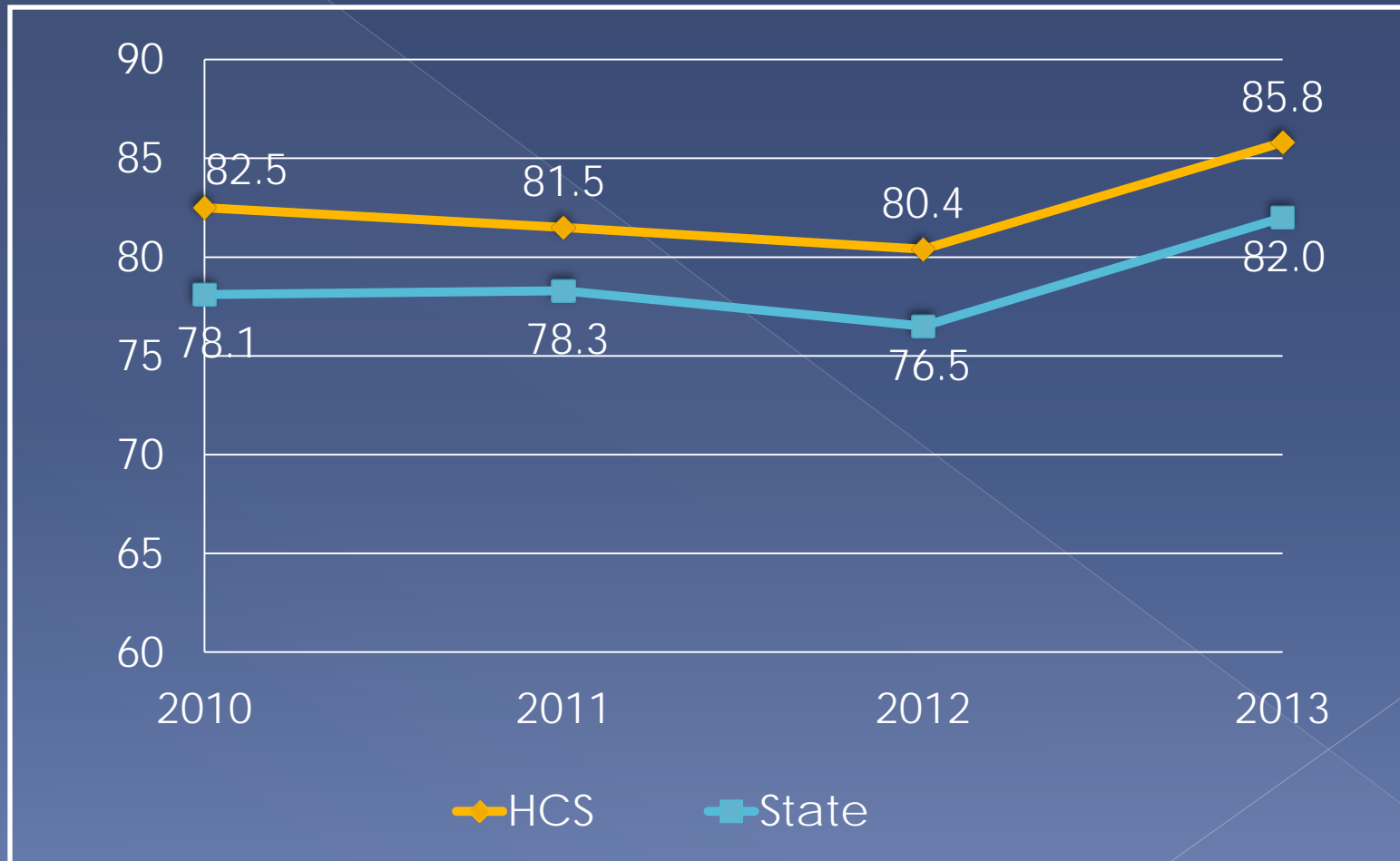

Grade 4: Percentage Met + Exemplary



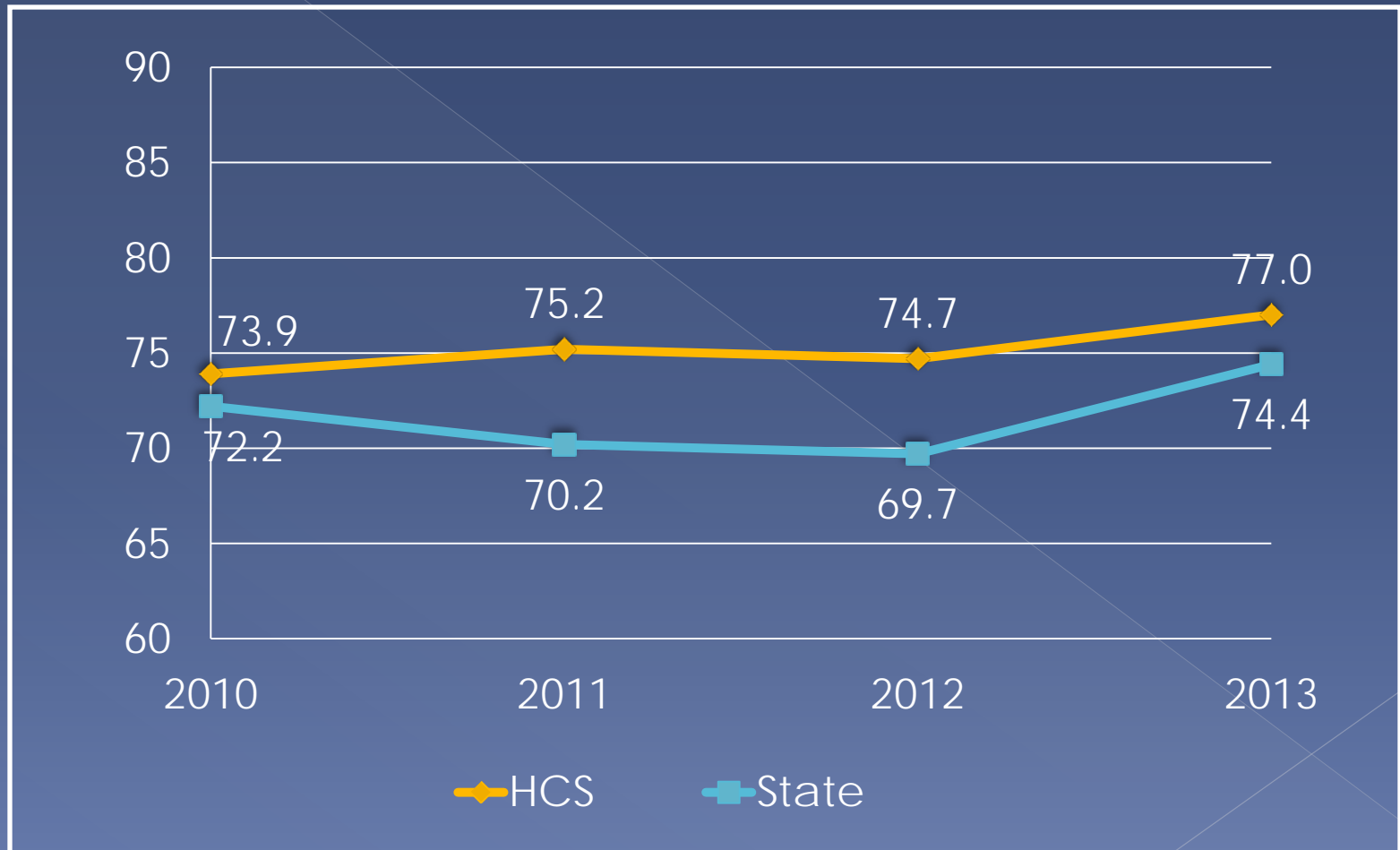

Grade 5: Percentage Met + Exemplary



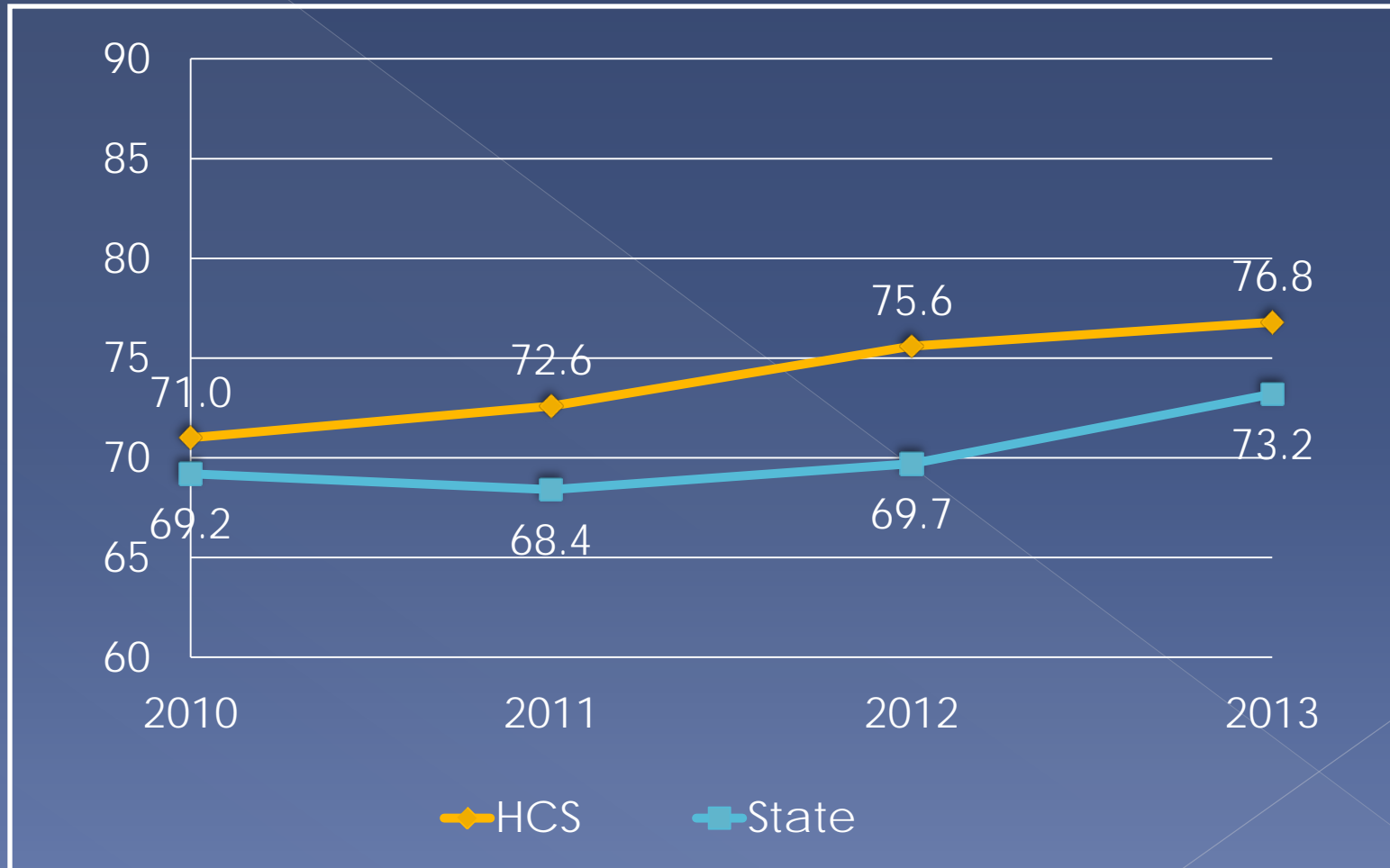

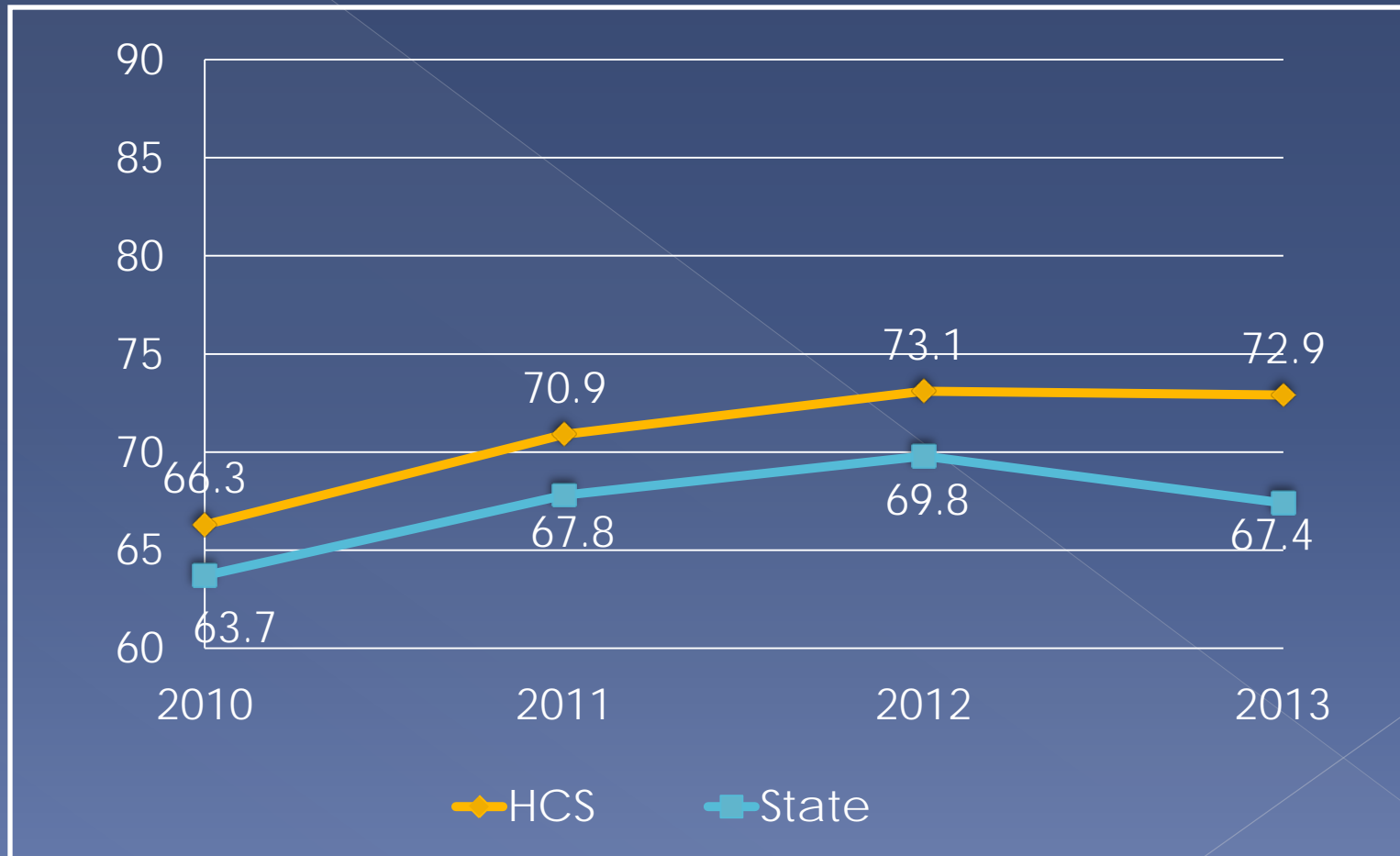

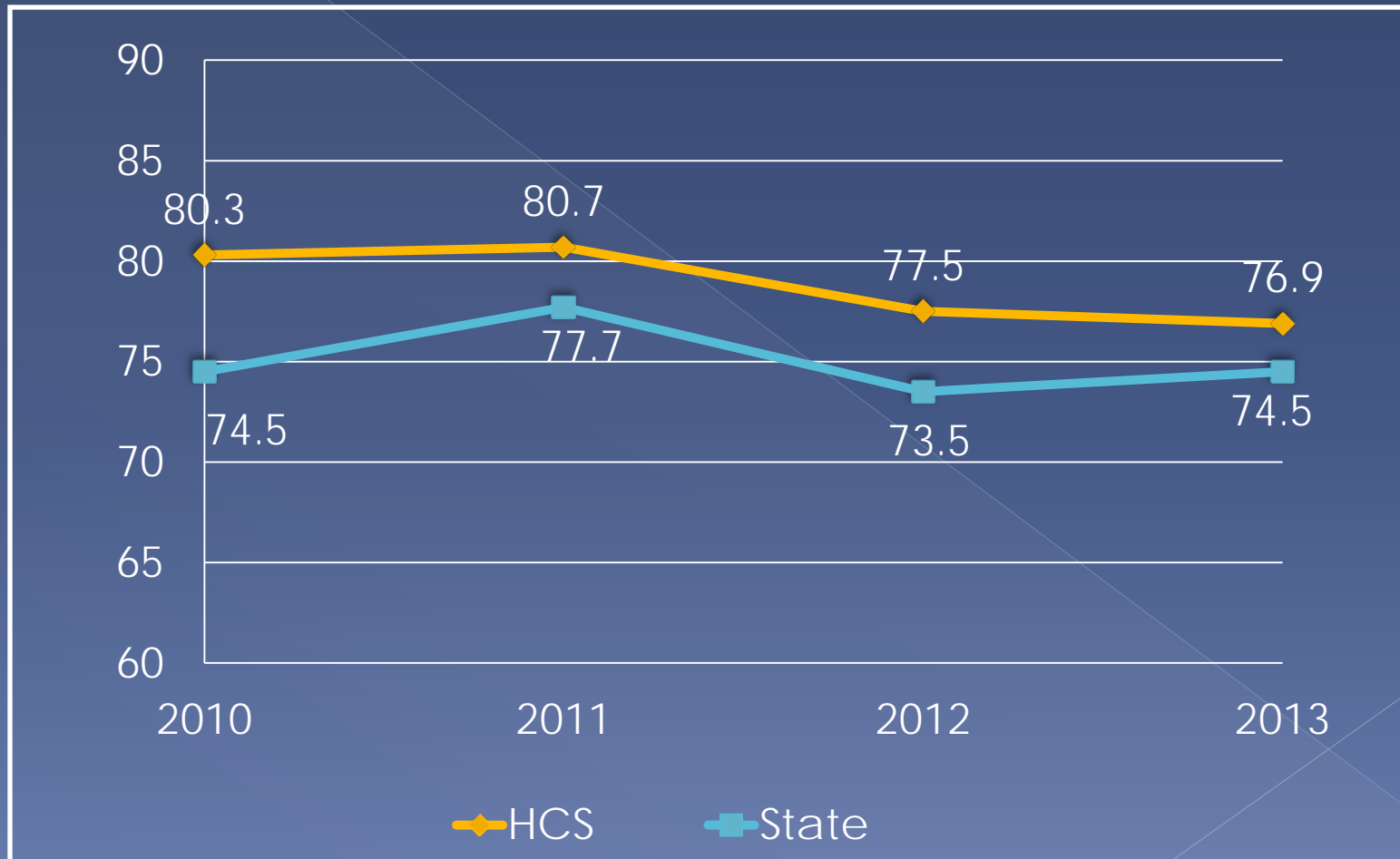

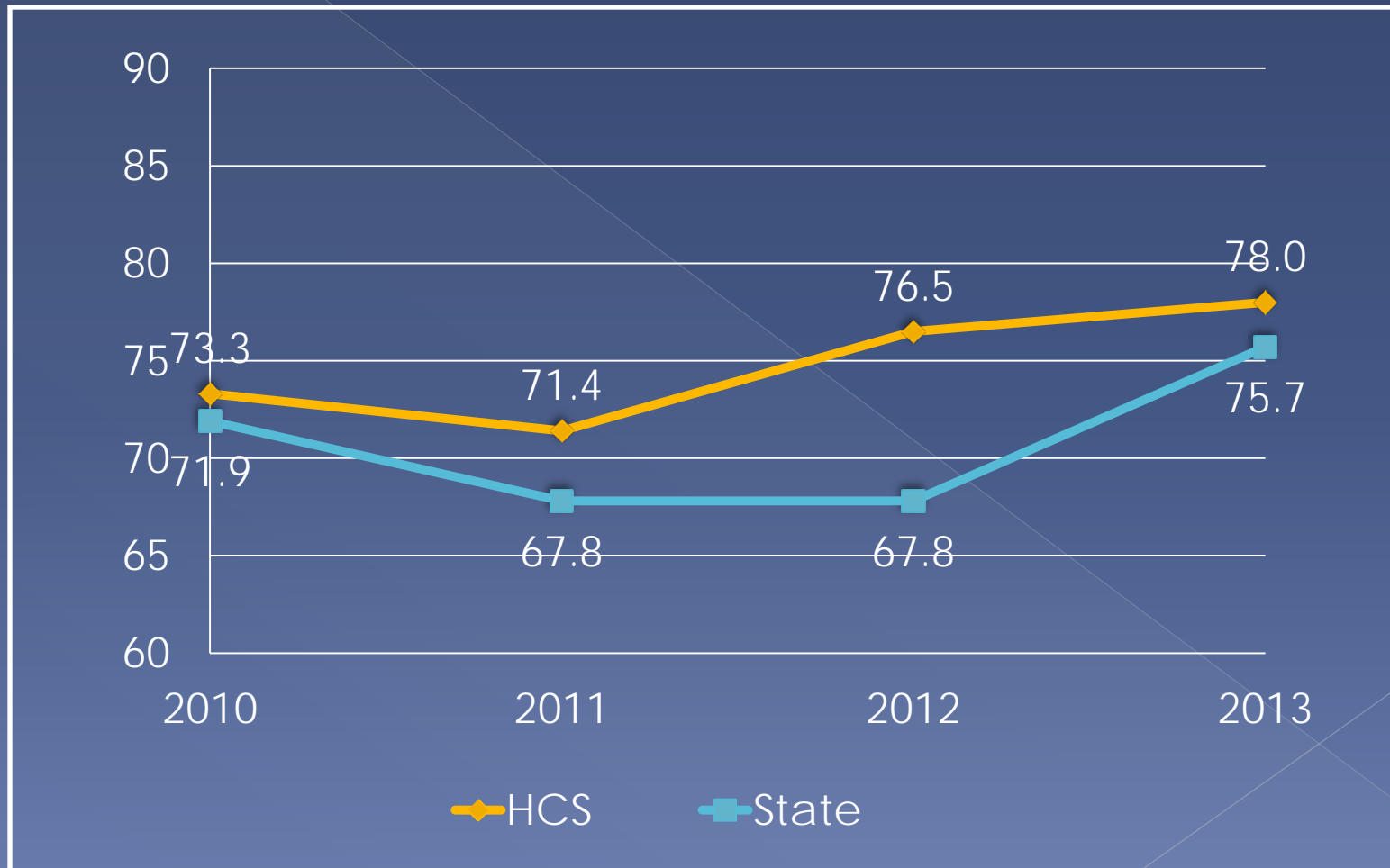

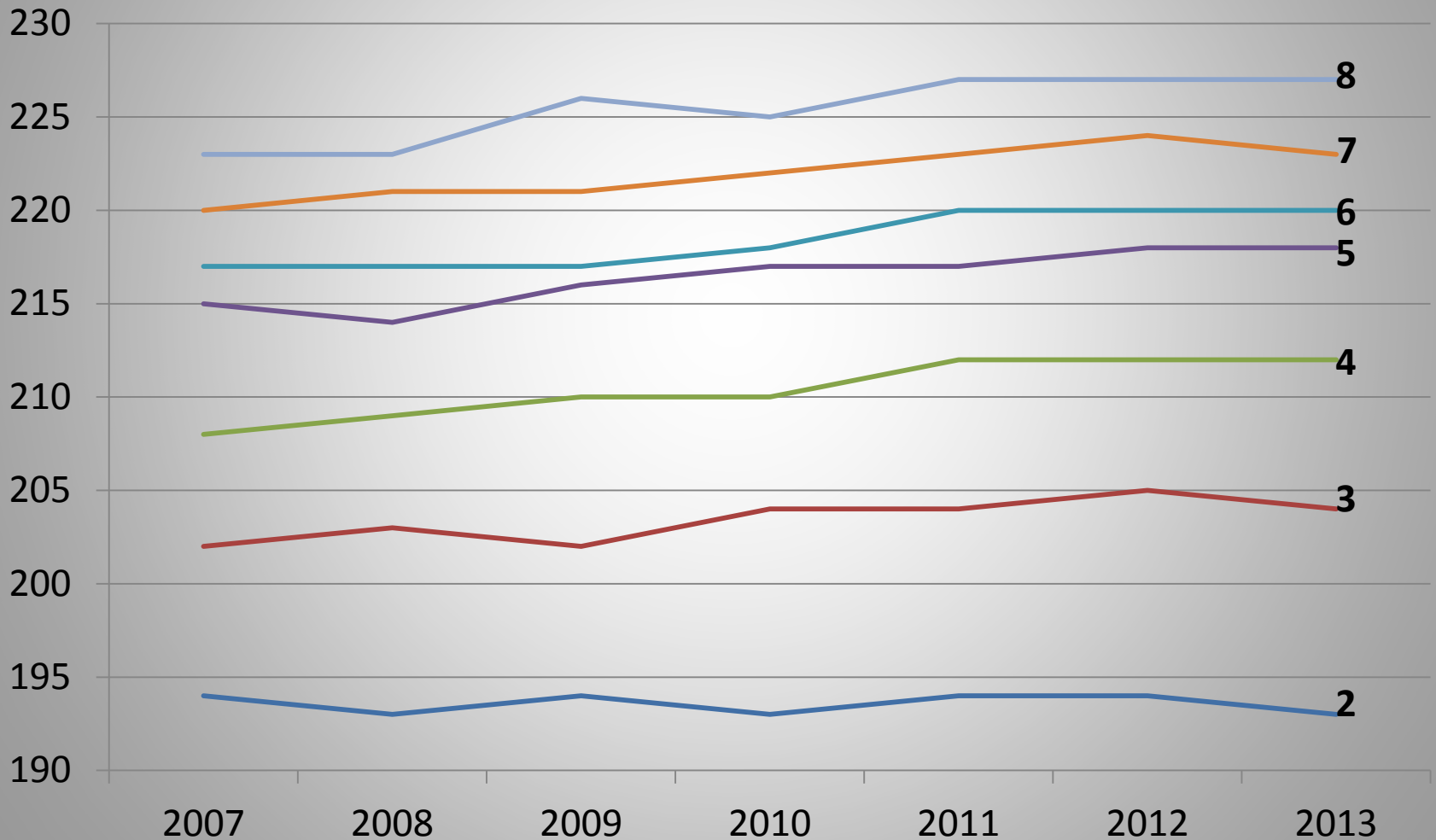

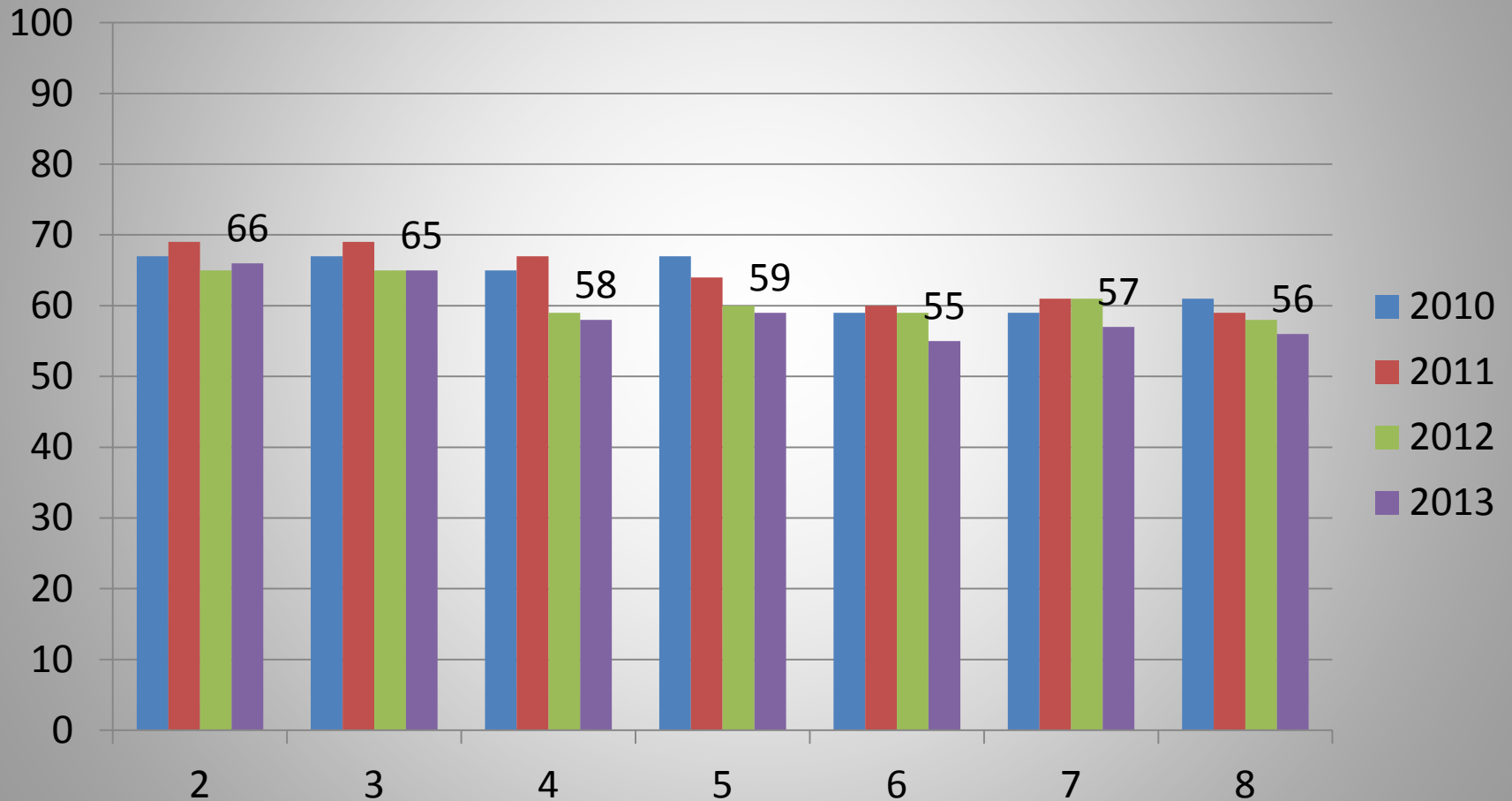
MAP Reading Scores Over Time

Spring Median RIT



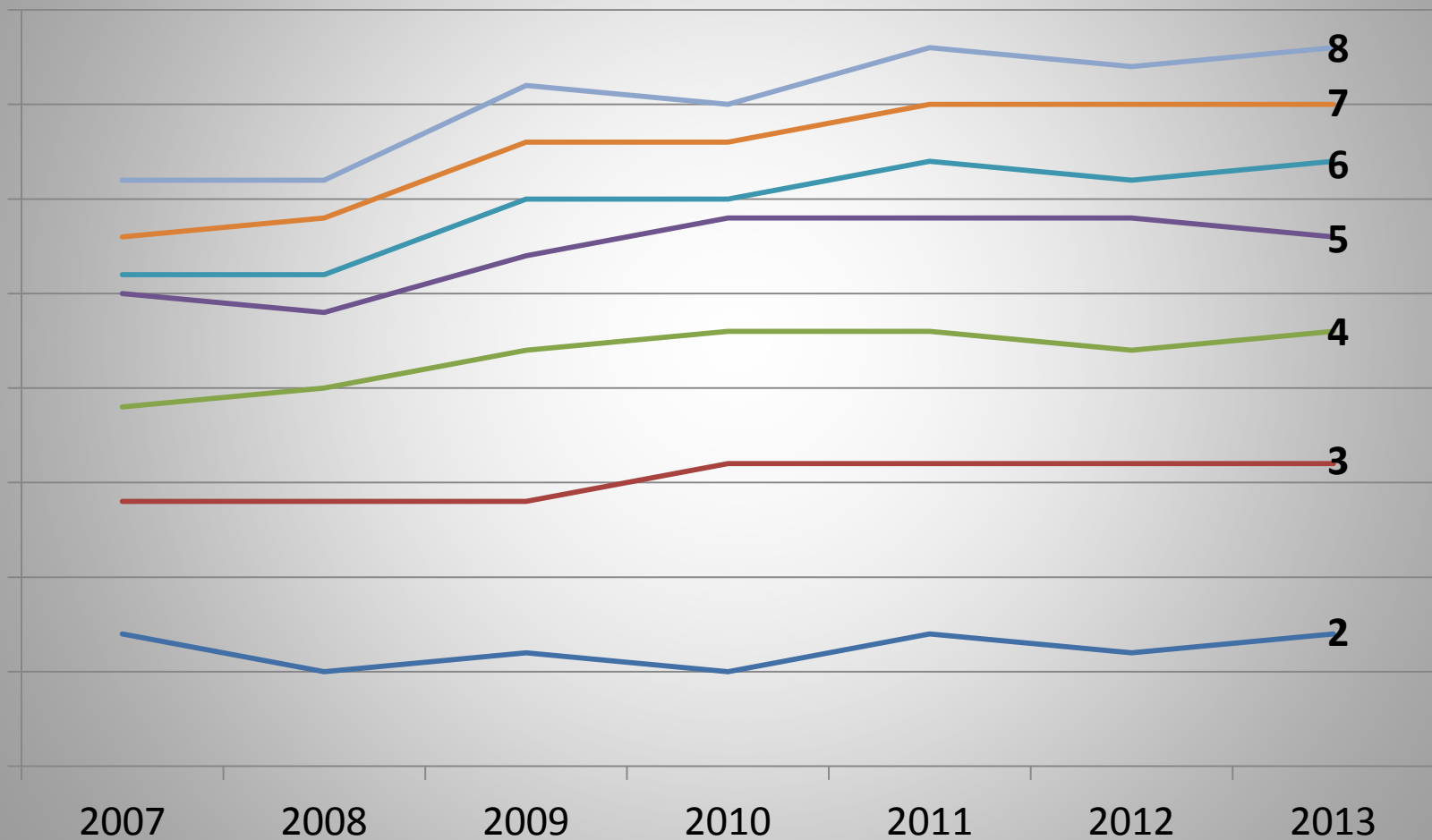
MAP Reading Growth Goals

MAP Language Scores Over Time

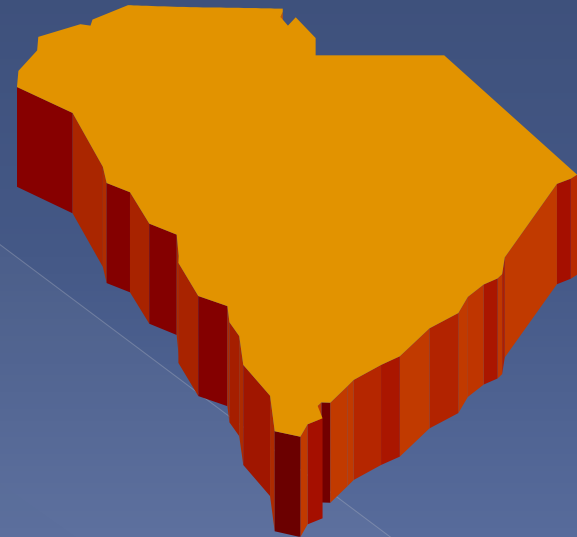

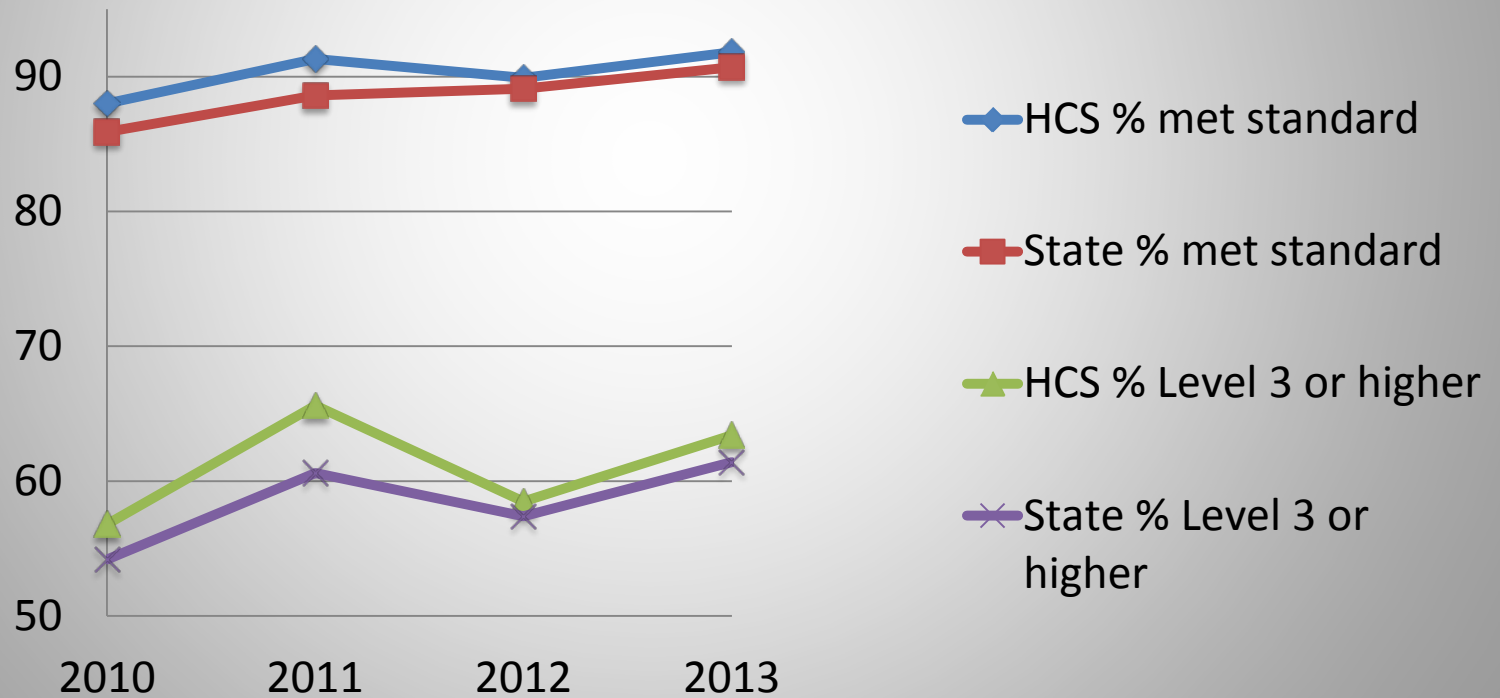

Performance of second year high school students 2010-2013



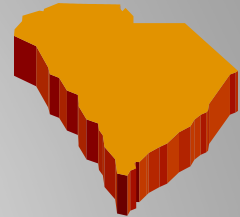

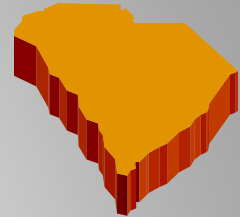

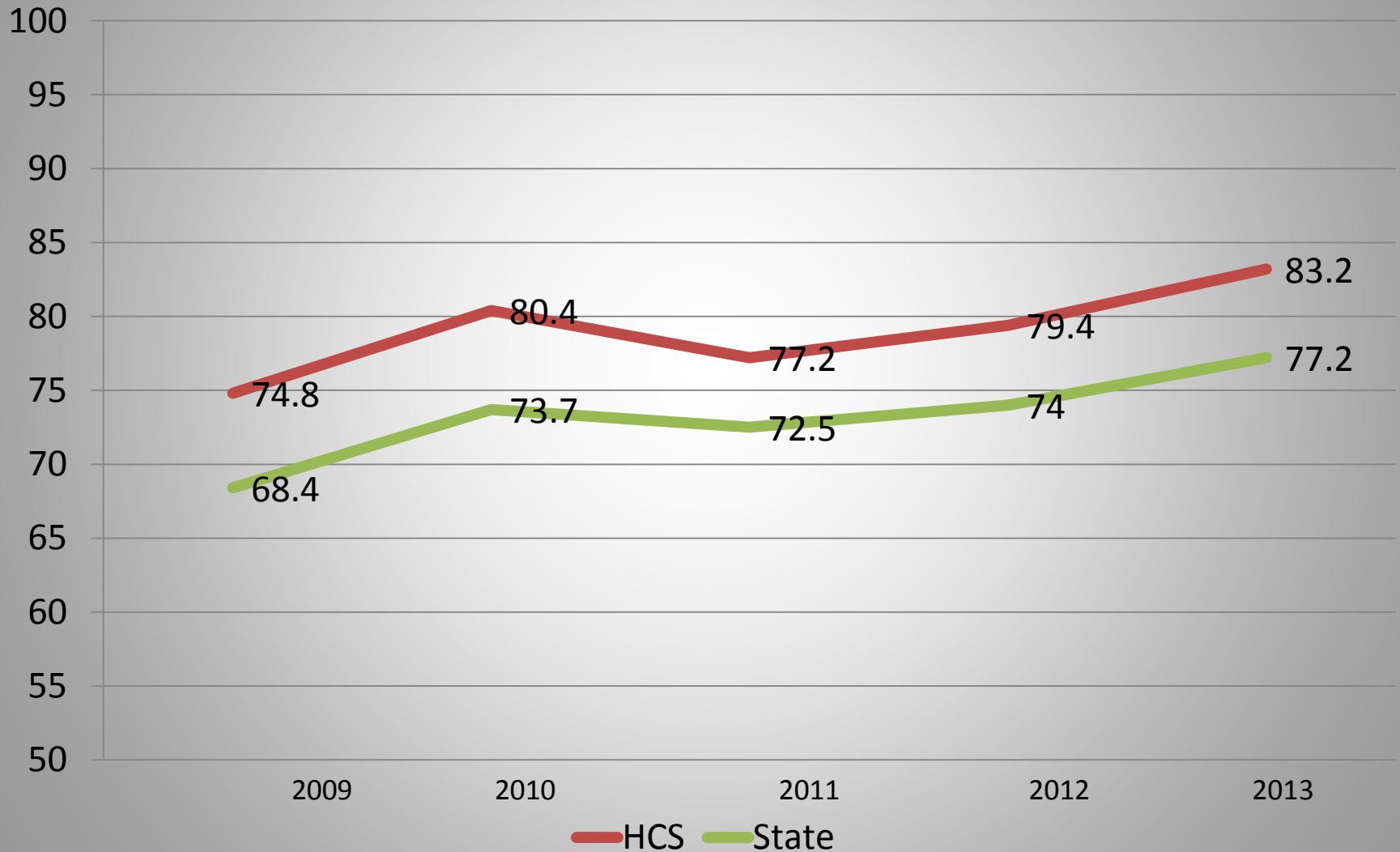

% Passing



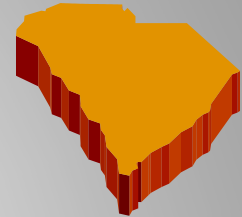
