


Monitoring Report on Literacy



Second grade reading level

 MEASURE: MAP Reading (Spring) Lexile range for grade 2; percentage of students reading within expected Lexile range








Proficiency level grades 3-HS

Increase the percentage of students in grades 3-HS who score at proficiency/passing level

• MEASURES: Aggregated percentage scoring Met or higher on PASS Reading in grades 3-8, Level 3 or higher on HSAP English Language Arts, and passing English I end-of-course test








MAP Reading Scores Over Time

Spring Median RIT




MAP Reading Growth Goals

MAP Language Scores Over Time










