<u>Project Scope:</u>	The project includes approximately 30,500 SF addition (classrooms, resources rooms, planning, mini-gym, and multi-purpose room). The existing facility will be renovated including drainage improvements, a new loop road, playground improvements, expansion to the media center (approximately 800 SF), expansion to the kitchen (approximately 600 SF) and interior renovations to all areas.			
Current Status:	Commissioning, acoustical testing, LEED certification, as-built documents, punch list remedial work and financial closeout is substantially complete.

<u>Schedule Issues:</u>	As a result of the repairs to the fire alarm system caused by a lightning strike, OSF and the State Fire Marshall directed HCS to upgrade the existing fire alarm system to meet the latest life safety codes. The upgrade was completed in December and the OSF/SFM inspection was performed on December 20.			
<u>Achievements:</u>	New Addition and Renovation Work for Phase 2 were completed and ready for the start of the 2013-14 school year.
