New CATE Initiatives:

- A new course we are working on for 2014-15 is Exploring Computer Science, which incorporates computer operations, coding, various programming components, and robotics.
- HCS has implemented the use of Workkeys testing of senior CATE completers at ATA and AAST for 2013-2014 with training provided through utilizing Work Ready 101 curriculum. We will be testing approximately 250 seniors this year and expanding the program to high schools for the 2014-15 school year beginning with SJH.

- Five of our high school IBA programs (ATA, AAST, GSFH, LH, SH) as part of a pilot program with the state department have become Microsoft IT centers for testing. Students who meet required proficiency standards with word and excel will be tested at the school sites for Nationally recognized credentialing. We plan to expand this testing to other Microsoft certification areas for 2014-15.
- HCS is working on the development of a Technical Scholars program with HGTC where senior students will be allowed to attend HGTC within technical skill training areas such as the new Machine Tool program. This will allow students interested in a technical field to begin advanced training in areas not currently offered by HCS. This program allows for the partnership to offer the program without duplication of services.
- MBH is reviewing school majors in an effort to expand and offer Hospitality as a major with emphasis on entrepreneurship.
