4th Annual Advanced Placement® District Honor Roll

A total of 477 school districts across the U.S. and Canada are being honored by the College Board® for simultaneously increasing access to Advanced Placement® course work while maintaining or increasing the percentage of students earning scores of 3 or higher on AP® Exams. Horry County Schools is one of only 5 districts in South Carolina to meet this criteria for placement on the AP® District Honor Roll.

Criteria used for inclusion in the AP® District Honor Roll:

1. Increased access to AP® courses by
 - At least 4% in large districts
 - At least 6% in medium districts
 - At least 11% in small districts
2. Performance levels were maintained or improved when comparing the percentage of exams scoring 3 or higher from 2011 to 2013
