

Loris High School Curtain Wall and Courtyard Repairs

Policy Reference:

OE-13: The superintendent shall assure that physical facilities support the accomplishment of the board's **Results** policies, are safe and properly maintained.

Background Information: Repairs are necessary at Loris High School on some exterior windows and the courtyard brick curtain wall to prevent water intrusion into the building. A project scope and budget was developed and presented to the Facilities Committee for approval on April 23, 2018. The project was approved by the Board of Education with funding at \$150,000.00 on April 23, 2018. After two bid postings, a responsible bidder has been selected with a low bid of \$175,000.00. Staff requests that the Board approve increasing the budget for this project to \$175,000.00, using \$25,000.00 from the sustainment contingency funds.

Purpose: To secure additional funding from the sustainment contingency funds to repair the Loris High School curtain wall and courtyards.
