## Information

**Background Information:** The Instructional Materials Division of the State Department of Education anticipates allocations to fully fund the subject areas up for adoption in the 2018-2019 school year. Selected materials will be placed in schools beginning August 2019. Recommendations are currently being made to support identified areas of Street Law, Forensic Science, Advanced Grammar and Composition, Journalism, and Speech.

All materials for this adoption went through the state public review process prior to consideration. The district adoption committee was comprised of teachers, ESOL representatives, administrators, and a parent. School-level representatives were instructed to vote based on input from all appropriate teachers in their schools.
