Background Information: At the November 13, 2017, Board meeting, the administration shared the Opinion of Probable Costs for the existing Myrtle Beach Middle School Renovation and requested that the Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) method be utilized for the construction activity. The estimated cost was TDB in conjunction with the Board approval of funding for the project. The Board approved to allow the staff to utilize the Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) method for the existing Myrtle Beach Middle School Renovation project.

At the November 15, 2017 Finance Committee Meeting, the funding source for the existing Myrtle Beach Middle School Renovation project was discussed. The total project budget for the renovation is \$21,128,943. The committee identified potential funding sources for the project and recommended the funding for the project be presented to the full Board at the November 20, 2017 Board Meeting.
